2.The petitioner is seeking directions to the first to third respondents to consider the petitioner's representation dated 29.10.2018 in relation to removal of encroachment in Survey No.64/2 of Vadamugam Kangiyampalayam Village, Uthukuli Taluk, Tiruppur District, which has been put up by respondent nos.4 to 8. The said representation is addressed to the District Collector, Tiruppur District. A copy of the said representation has also been forwarded to respondent nos.2 and 3.

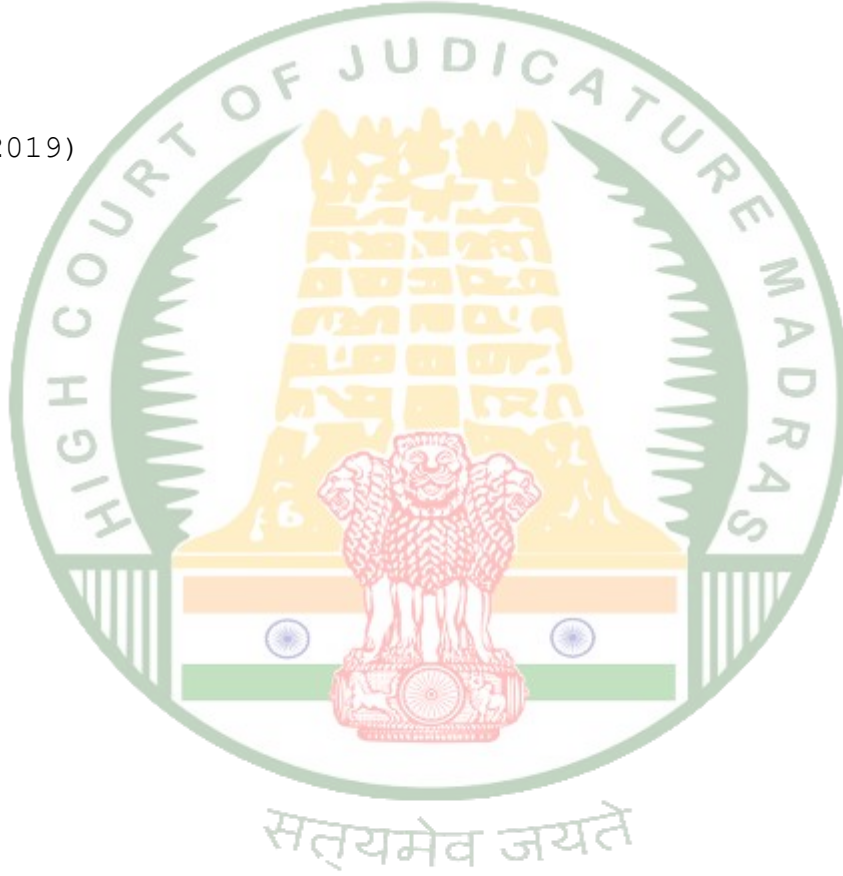
