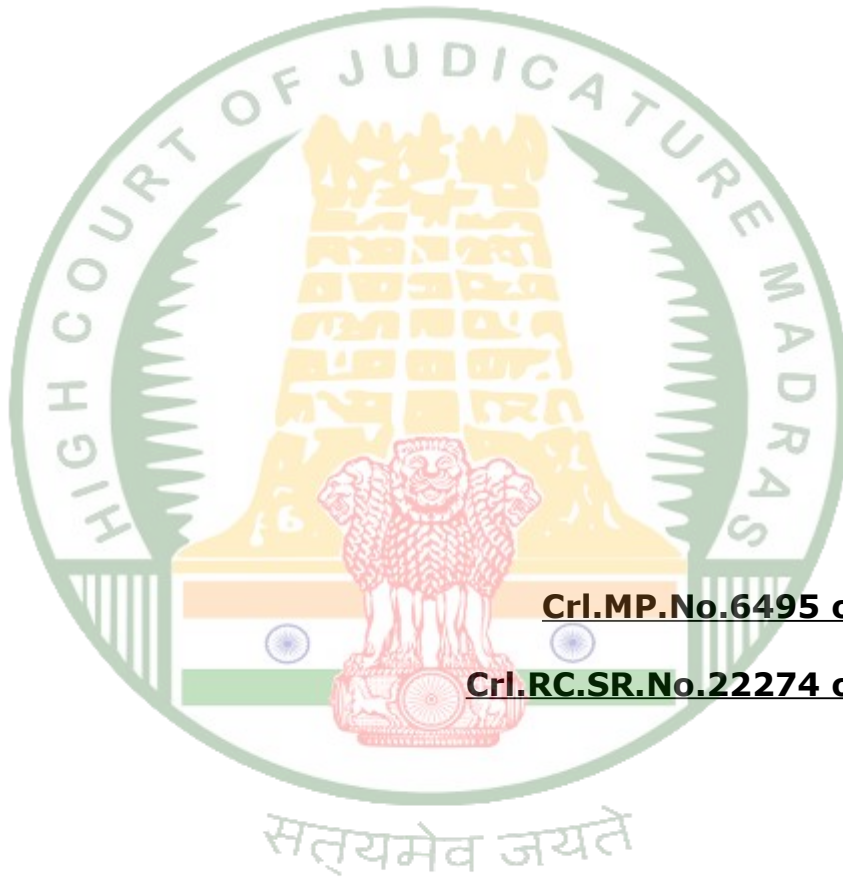
3. The Registry is directed to number the Criminal Revision Petition after the petitioners file the proof for the deposit of the cost imposed by this Court.
