2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned Standing Counsel for the respondents 1 to 3 and the learned Special Government Pleader for the fourth respondent.

3.Since the statutory appeal has already been filed before the fourth respondent, this Court without going into the merits of the case, directs the fourth respondent to dispose of the statutory appeal filed by the petitioner, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. 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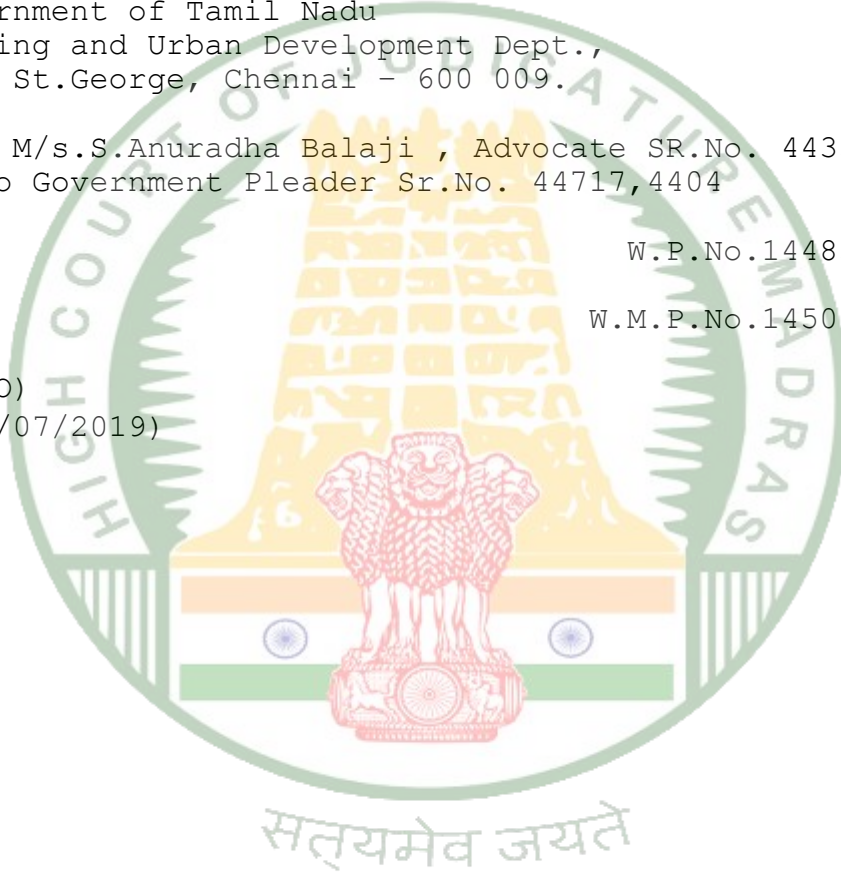
