Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, to issue a Writ of Habeas Corpus to call for the entire records leading to the detention of petitioner's husband Sathish @ Karunakaran, aged 26 years, son of Rajendran, M.Kalipatty, Mettur Taluk, Salem District, presently detained in Central Prison, Salem under Act 14/1982 as a 'Goonda' vide the detention order dated 24.04.2019 in C.M.P.No.18/Goonda'/C2/2019 on the file of the second respondent herein, directing to produce the person or body of the detenu before this Court and thereafter set him at liberty from the Central Prison, Salem.

The petitioner challenges the impugned order of detention in C.M.P.No.18/Goonda'/C2/2019, dated 24.04.2019 detaining her husband as "Goonda", as contemplated under Section 2(f) of the Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 1982.

2. The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) reports that the order of detention passed against the detenu has been revoked by the Government by its order in G.O.Rt.No.2380 Home, Prohibition and Excise (XIV) Department, dated 05.07.2019 and he has also produced a copy of the Government Order. Recording the same, this Habeas Corpus Petition stands closed.
