Prayer: Criminal Original Petition is filed under Section 482 of Criminal Procedure Code, to direct the respondent Police to give permission and police protection to conduct the Light Music (Pattu Kacheri) in the event of Sri Muthu Mariamman Koil Festival on 14.06.2019 at Kil Koothapakkam Village, Kiliyanur, Vanur Taluk, Villupuram District based on the petitioner's representation dated 07.06.2019.

O R D E R

Seeking permission to conduct cultural programme Light Music - Pattu Kacheri in the event of the temple festival at Sri Muthu Mariamman Koil on 14.06.2019 at Kil Koothapakkam Village, Kiliyanur, Vanur Taluk, Villupuram District, the petitioner made a representation dated 07.06.2019 to the respondent. As the same has not been considered, the present Criminal Original petition has been filed.

2. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent.

3. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor, on instructions, would submit that there is likelihood of arising law and order problem.

4. A mere apprehension cannot be a ground to reject the representation. There is absolutely no material before this Court to hold that there will be a law and order problem in the event of permission being granted. In such view of the matter, the petitioner is permitted to conduct cultural programme in the event of Sri Muthu Mariamman Koil Festival at Kil Koothapakkam Village, Kiliyanur, Vanur Taluk, Villupuram District, on 14.06.2019, however with the following conditions:-

(a) The petitioner shall pay a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) as charges, to the respondent police and on receipt of the same, the respondent Police is directed to issue receipt and proceed further.

(b) The cultural programme in connection with the event of cultural programme (Pattu Kacheri) at Sri Muthu Mariamman Koil Festival at Kil Koothapakkam Village, Kiliyanur, Vanur Taluk, Villupuram District, shall be conducted on 14.06.2019 between 06.00 p.m. and 10.00 p.m.

(c) There should not be any kind of obscene dance or vulgar dialogues during the performance, by anyone of the participants.

(d) Double meaning songs should not be played so as to spoil the minds of students and youths.

(e) No dance or songs, touching upon any political party or religion or community or caste shall be played.

(f) No flex boards in support of any political party or communal leader, shall be erected at the premises of the programme.

(g) The function shall not affect either religious or communal harmony and shall be conducted without any discrimination based on caste.

(h) If there is violation of any one of the conditions imposed, the concerned police officer is at liberty to take necessary action, as per law and stop such performance forthwith; and

(i) Similarly, the police is directed to stop the dance programme, if it is played beyond the permitted time limit.

(j) The respondent is directed to issue necessary permission, incorporating the above conditions.

5. With the above directions, this Criminal Original Petition stands allowed.
