Prayer : Writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a Writ of Mandamus directing the 2nd and 4th respondents (1). Transferring the enquiry and investigation arising out of the complaint preferred by the petitioner dated 14.07.2015 from the file of 5th respondent to an Independent Investigation Officer as nominated by the 4th respondent or any other agency; 2. directing the 2nd respondent to conduct an enquiry under TN Police service Disciplinary and conduct Rules, to determine the prima facie case for a disciplinary enquiry against the errant public servants specified in the complaint of the petitioner dated 14.07.2015 and (3). direct the respondents to pay a compensation of Rs.2,00,000/- for the police excess caused against the petitioner by the errant police personnel.

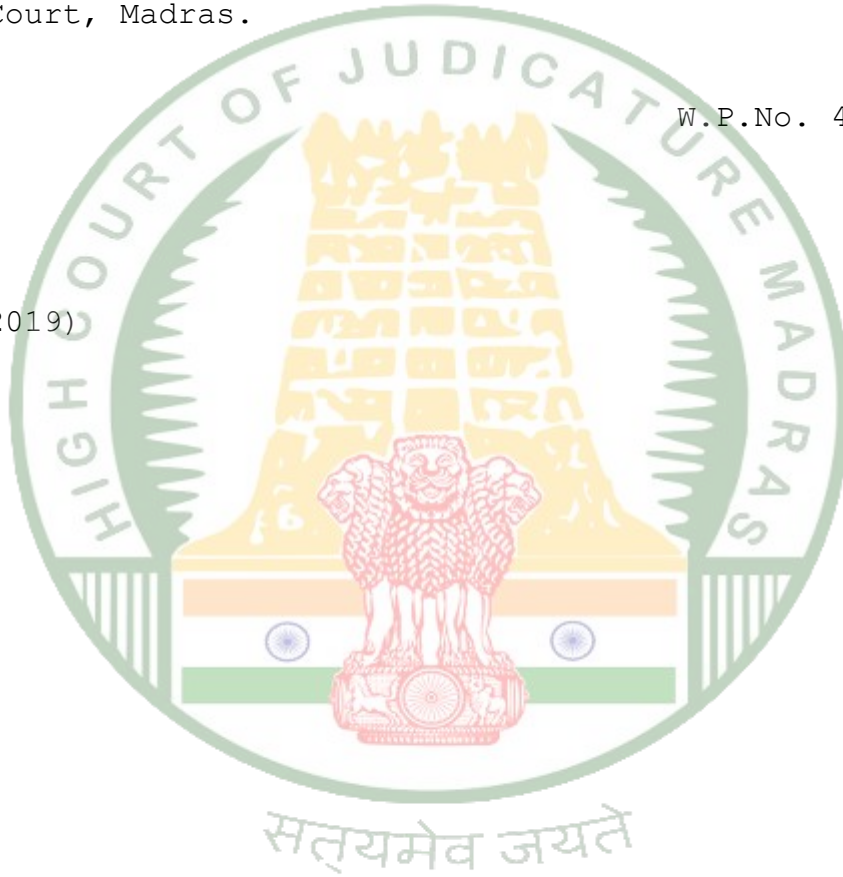
