2. Accordingly, the respondent present before this Court through video conference. He would submit that because of the election duties, he could not carry out the inspection. However, the order was passed as early as on 11.12.2020 and the elections were declared only in the last week of February 2021 and almost he had three months time. Therefore, the respondent is directed to file an affidavit with regard to as to why action should not be taken against him, for violating the Court's order, under the provisions of Contempt of Courts Act.
