Prayer : Writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a Writ of Mandamus forbearing the respondents 1 and 2 from interfering with the civil disputes in respect of the properties situated in Survey Nos.62/2A - 0.03.5, 62/2B - 0.03.0, 62/2C-0.02.5, 62/6A-0.05, 62/6B-0.09.5, 62/6C-0.06.5, 62/6D-0.03.0, 62/6E1-0.13.0, 62/6E2-0.13.0, 62/4A1-0.00.5, 62/4A2-0.04.0, Old S.No.62/5, New Survey No.62/5A1 well situated in this S.No.with 1/4th well water right, S.No.62/10A-0.11.5, 62/10B-0.03.0, 62/10C-0.03.0, 62/10D-0.03.0, well situated in Old S.No.62/5, New S.No.62/5A1 in this 1/3rd well water right. This writ petition has been filed to forbearing the respondents 1 and 2 from interfering with the civil disputes between the petitioner and respondents 3 and 4.

2. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that the complaint had lodged by the petitioner in C.S.R.No.245 of 2016 and the second respondent Inspector of Police has conducted an enquiry and closed the complaint on 11.10.2016. Therefore, nothing survives in this writ petition.

3. Considering the submission made by the learned Additional Public Prosecutor, the prayer sought for in this writ petition has become infructuous. Accordingly, this writ petition stands dismissed as infructuous. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
