Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, to issue a Writ of Habeas Corpus to call for the entire records leading to the detention of the petitioner's brother Ilaiya @ Ilaiyaraja, son of Arokiasamy, male, aged about 32 years, is presently lodged in Central Prison, Puzhal at Chennai and has been detained under Act 14/82 as a "Goonda" vide detention order dated 07.06.2019 on the file of the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent herein, made in BCDFGISSSV No.309/2019 and quash the same and consequently direct the respondents herein to produce the body and person of the said detenu before this Court and set at liberty from the Central Prison, Puzhal, Chennai.

The petitioner challenges the impugned order of detention in BCDFGISSSV No.309/2019, dated 09.06.2019, detaining her brother as "Goonda", as contemplated under Section 2(f) of the Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 1982.

2. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor reports that the order of detention passed against the detenu has been revoked by

the Government by its order in G.O.Rt.No.2504 Home, Prohibition and Excise (X) Department, dated 12.07.2019 and he has also produced a copy of the Government Order. Recording the same, this Habeas Corpus Petition stands closed.

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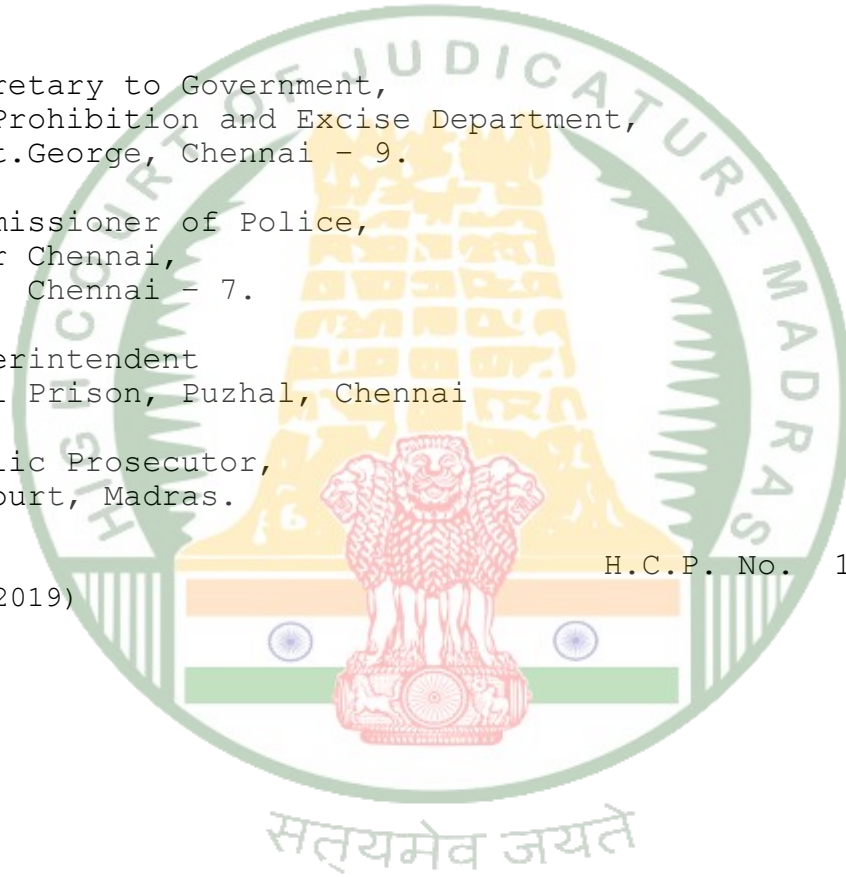
