Utthaman, who is confined at Central Prison, Salem and set aside the same and direct the respondents to produce the detenu before this Court and set him at liberty.

The petitioner challenges the impugned order of detention in in C.M.P.No.23/B.L.A./C2/2019, dated 14.06.2019, detaining his son as "Bootlegger", as contemplated under Section 2(b) of the Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 1982.

The learned Additional Public Prosecutor reports that the order of detention passed against the detenu has been revoked by the Government by its order in G.O.Rt.No.2657 Home, Prohibition and Excise (XIV) Department, dated 26.07.2019 and he has also produced a copy of the Government Order. Recording the same, this Habeas Corpus Petition stands closed.

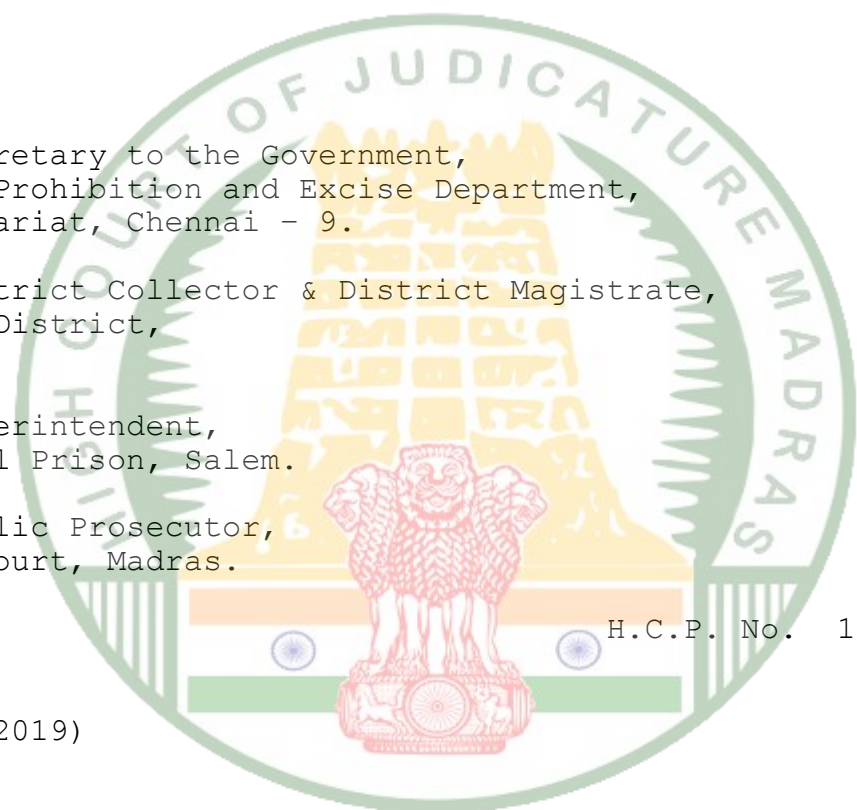
