On a perusal of the order, it is seen that it has been observed therein that the petitioner has to produce the certificate proving the nature of relationship between himself and the other persons. If the petitioner has got any grievance, he can very well challenge the aforesaid order in the manner known to law. Accordingly, the contempt petition stands closed, giving liberty to the petitioner to put to challenge the order passed by the Sub Collector, Hosur, if so advised.
