ORDER

This petition has been filed to direct the respondent to add additional provision namely Section 4 of the Tamil Nadu Women Harassment Act in the F.I.R. in Crime No.443 of 2019 registered on 04.04.2019 under the circumstances of the case.

2. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor on instructions would submit that the FIR was registered only on 04.04.2019 for offences under Sections 341, 294(b), 323, 506(2) of I.P.C. The investigation is in progress. If in the course of investigation, the respondent police collect sufficient materials, the offences will be accordingly altered and all the accused persons will be brought to book.

3. In view of the above submission, there shall be a direction to the respondent to continue the investigation effectively and based on the materials collected during the course of investigation, either alter the FIR or file the final

report by showing the necessary offences. All the persons involved in the crime shall also be made as accused persons.

4. This Criminal Original Petition is disposed of with the above direction.

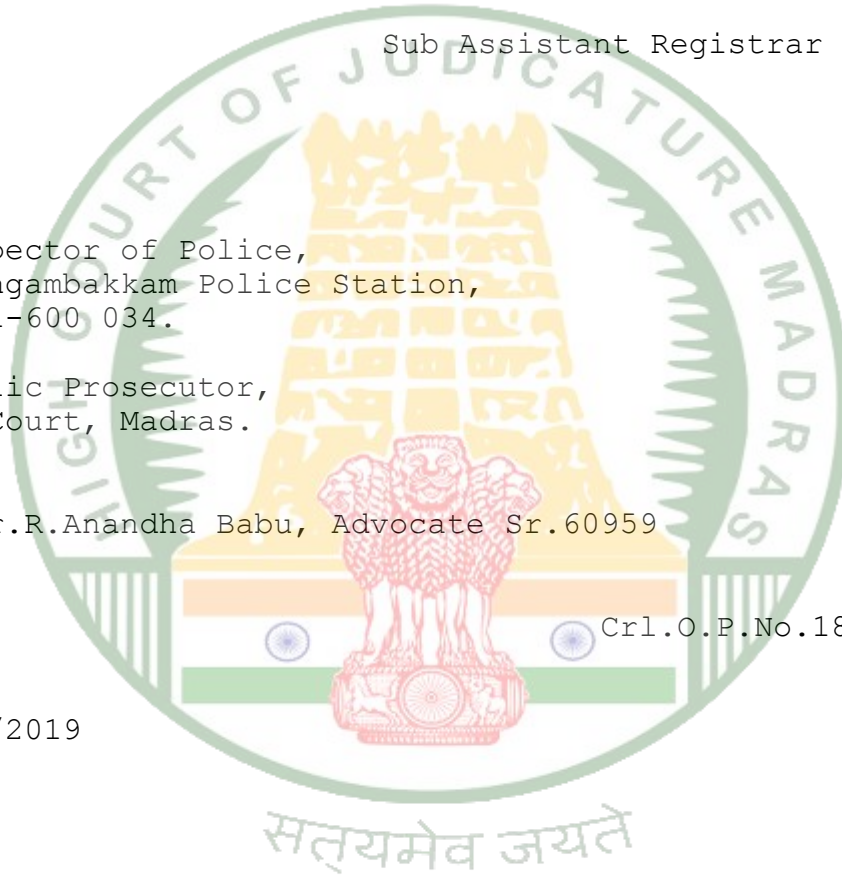
