registered, the question of "Not to harass" will not arise. Any

direction issued by this Court at this stage will amount to interfering with the investigation conducted by the respondent police.

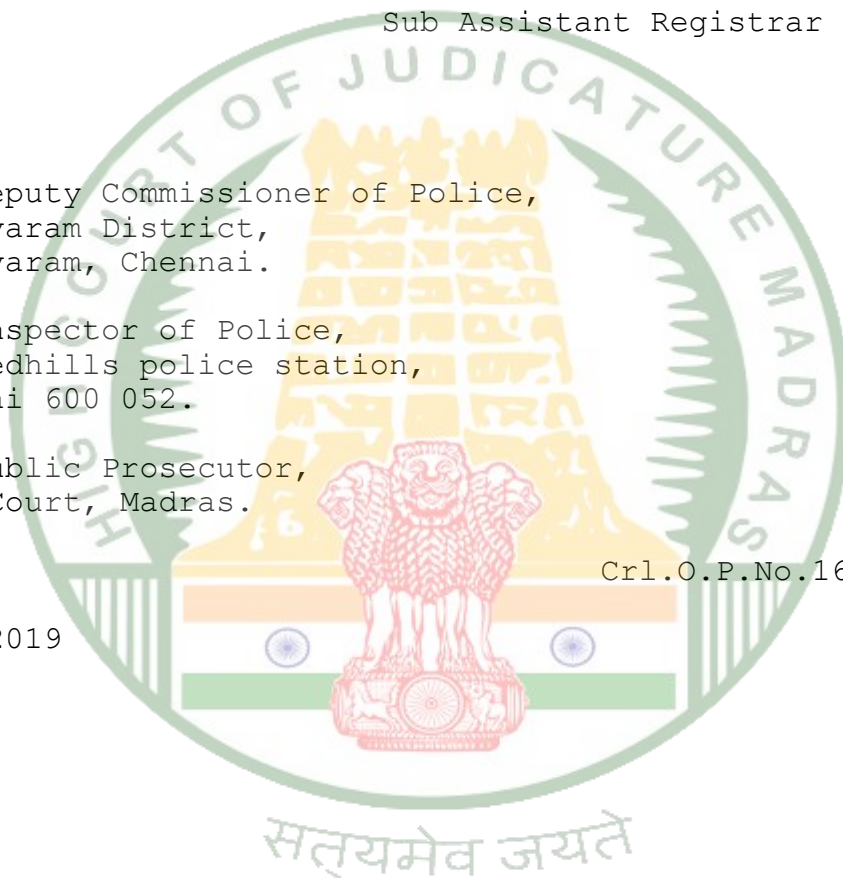
