Prayer: Criminal Original Petition is filed under Section 482 of Criminal Procedure Code, to issue a direction to extend the time to deposit 20% of the Cheque amount within 2 months imposed by the learned Principle District & Sessions Judge at Thiruvallur in Crl.M.P.No.5495/2018 in C.A.No.175/2018 order dated 25.10.2018.

O R D E R

This petition has been filed seeking to extend the time for deposit of 20% of the compensation amount, which was imposed as a condition by the Appellate Court while suspending sentence imposed against the petitioner, who was convicted for an offence under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instrument Act.

2.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the 20% of the compensation amount which works out to Rs.2,00,000/-, has been made ready and it will be immediately deposited in compliance with the condition imposed by the Court below.

3.This Criminal Original Petition is disposed of by giving one last opportunity to the petitioner to deposit the 20% of the compensation amount (Rs.2,00,000/-) on or before 05.07.2019. The other conditions imposed by the Court below shall stand as it is. It is made clear that if the petitioner fails to comply with the condition within the time stipulated by this Court, the suspension of sentence granted in favour of the petitioner shall stand cancelled without any further reference to this Court.

4.This Criminal Original Petition is disposed of accordingly.

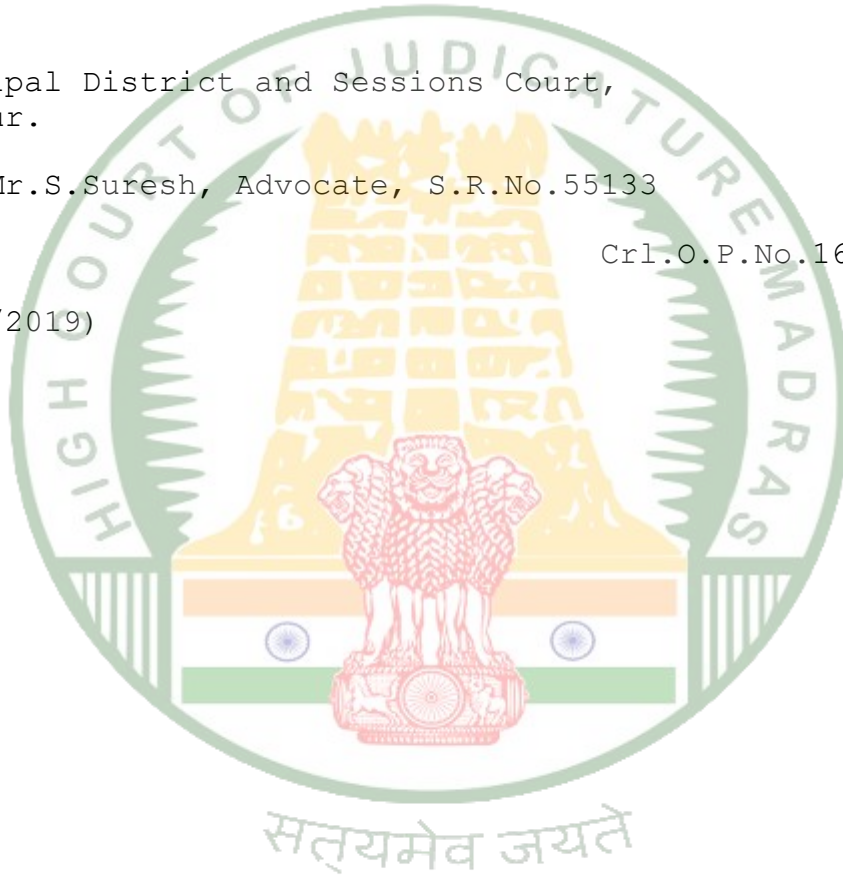
