COMMON ORDER

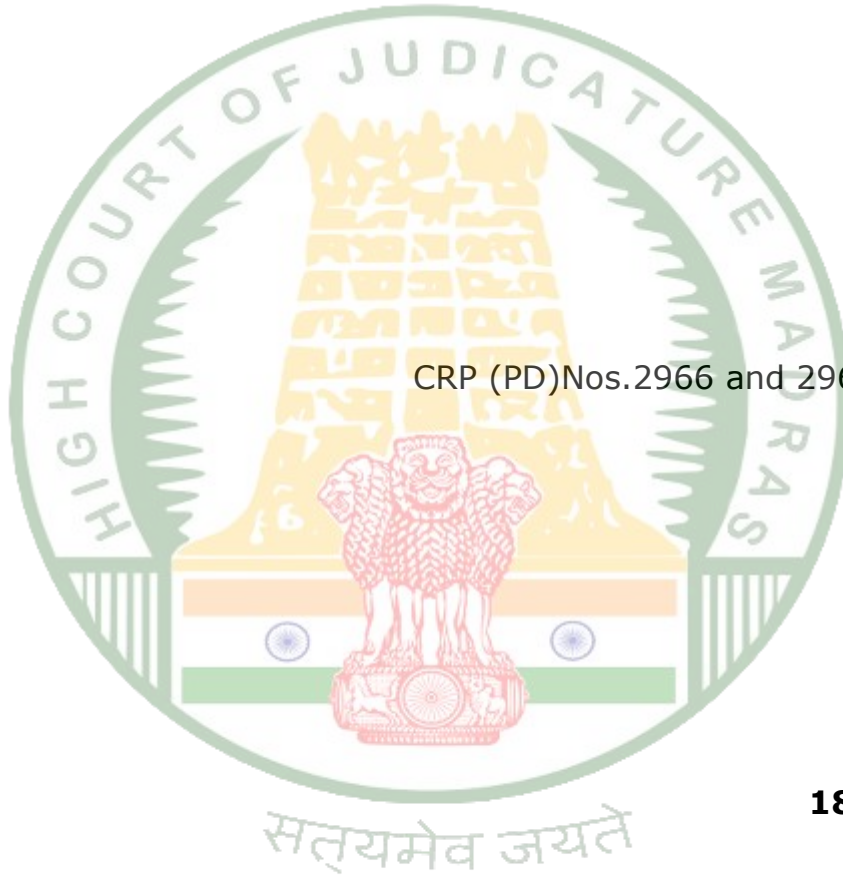
