[Order of the court was made by Justice M.M.SUNDRESH]

The petitioner is the husband of the detainee - Mrs.Ranjitha and father of the minor detainee - K.Shivani and minor detenu - K.Siddharth. He has come up with this petition seeking a direction to the 2nd respondent for production of the missing detainees.

2. The detainee - Ranjitha, who is the wife of the petitioner, is present in court along with her minor children. On enquiry, she has expressed her willingness to go with the petitioner, who is her husband. She has further stated that she was not in the illegal custody of anybody.

3. In view of the above, we do not find any illegal custody involved and thus, this Habeas Corpus Petition stands closed accordingly setting the detainees at liberty.

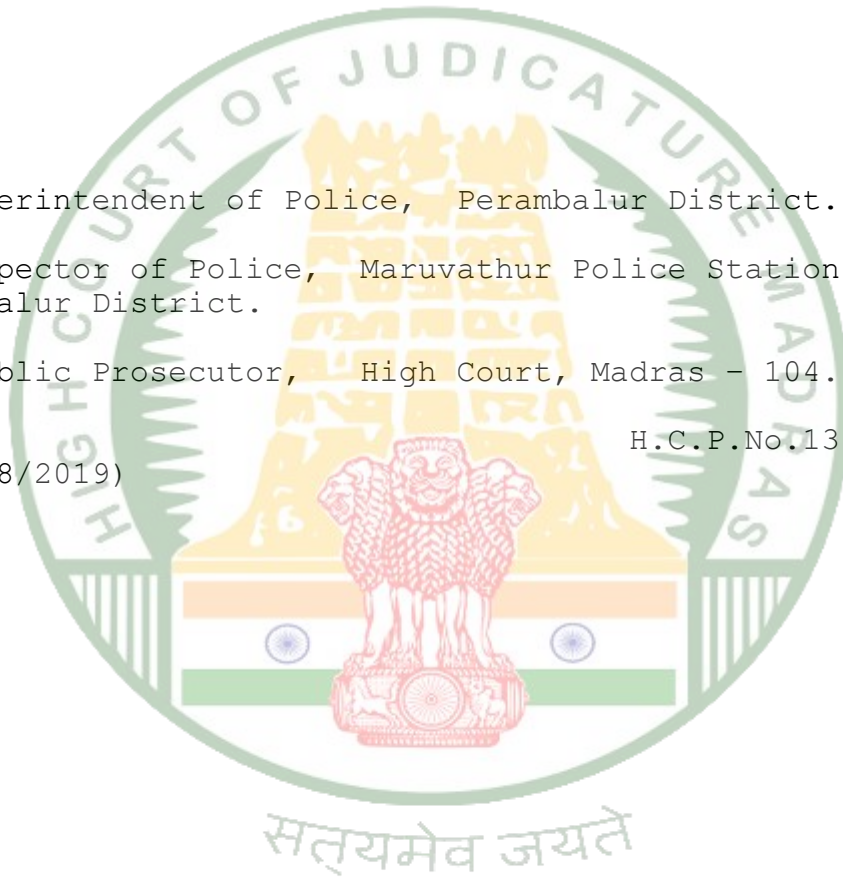
