3. Even though the matter is posted today for dismissal, there is no representation on the side of the petitioner.

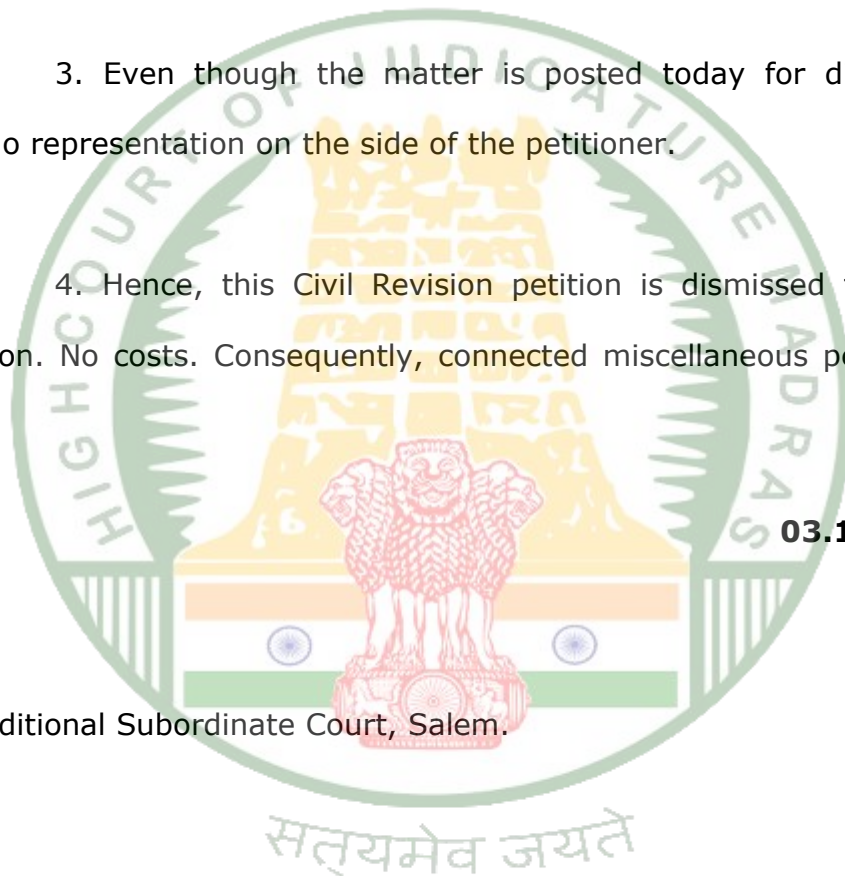
4. Hence, this Civil Revision petition is dismissed for non-prosecution. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
