Writ Petition has been filed for a direction to the Second Respondent to number and dispose of the appeal dated 19.09.2016 filed by the Petitioner under Section 18 (1) of the Arms Act 1959.

2. Learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the Respondents, on instructions, states that the appeal has been taken on file and hearing for the same has been fixed at 4.45 p.m on 15.10.2019 before the Second Respondent, for which copy of the notice of enquiry has been produced. A report of compliance of the action taken shall be filed before the Registrar (Judicial) of this Court by 31.01.2020.

4. The Writ Petition is disposed on the aforesaid terms. No costs.
