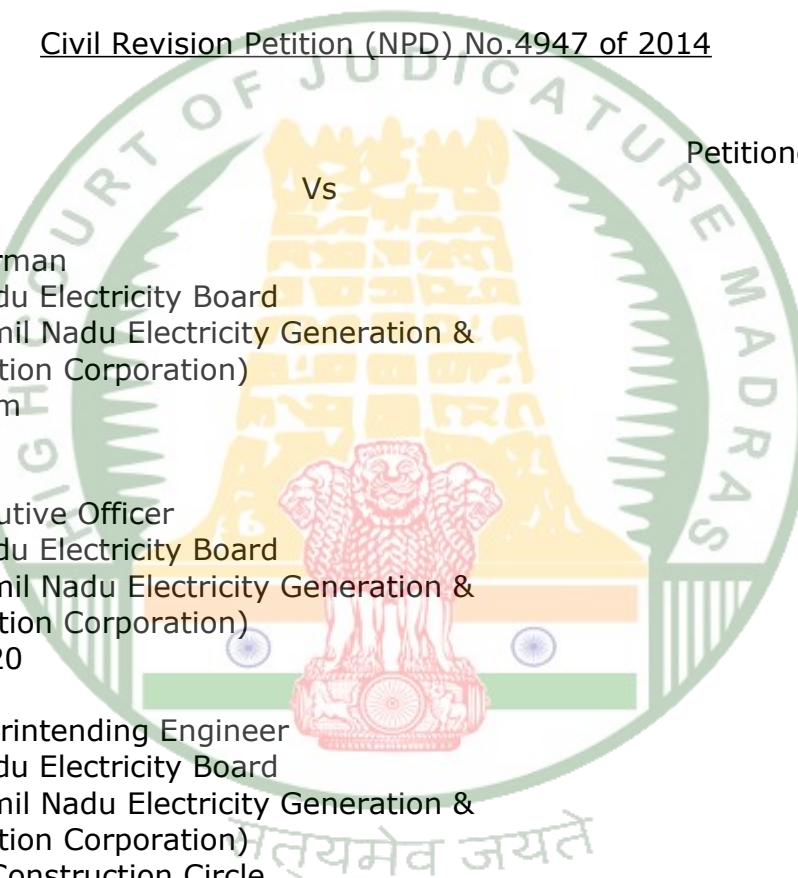

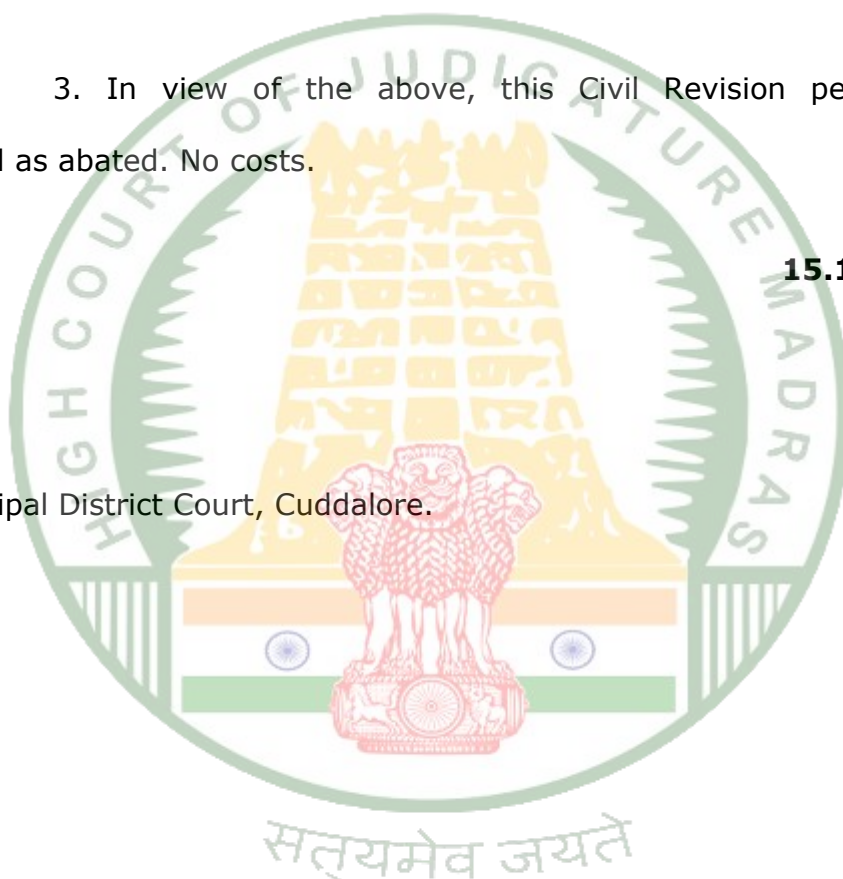
3. In view of the above, this Civil Revision petition is dismissed as abated. No costs.
