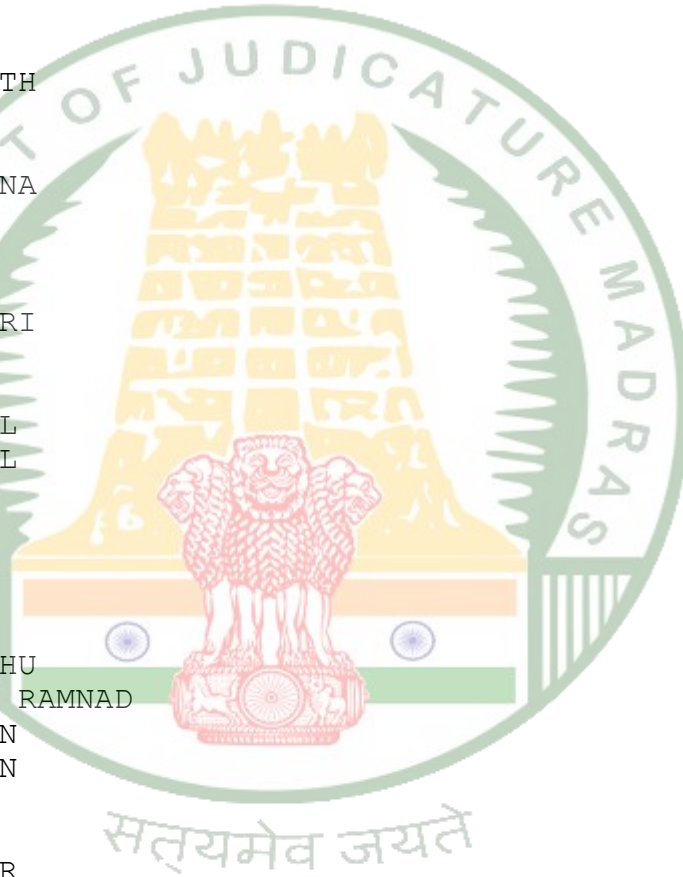

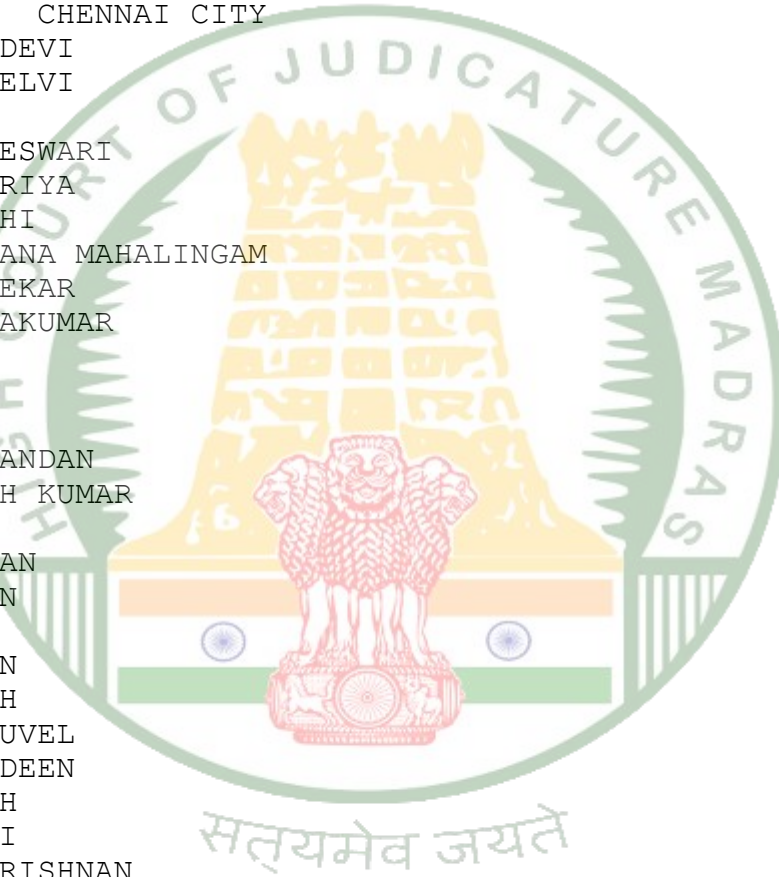

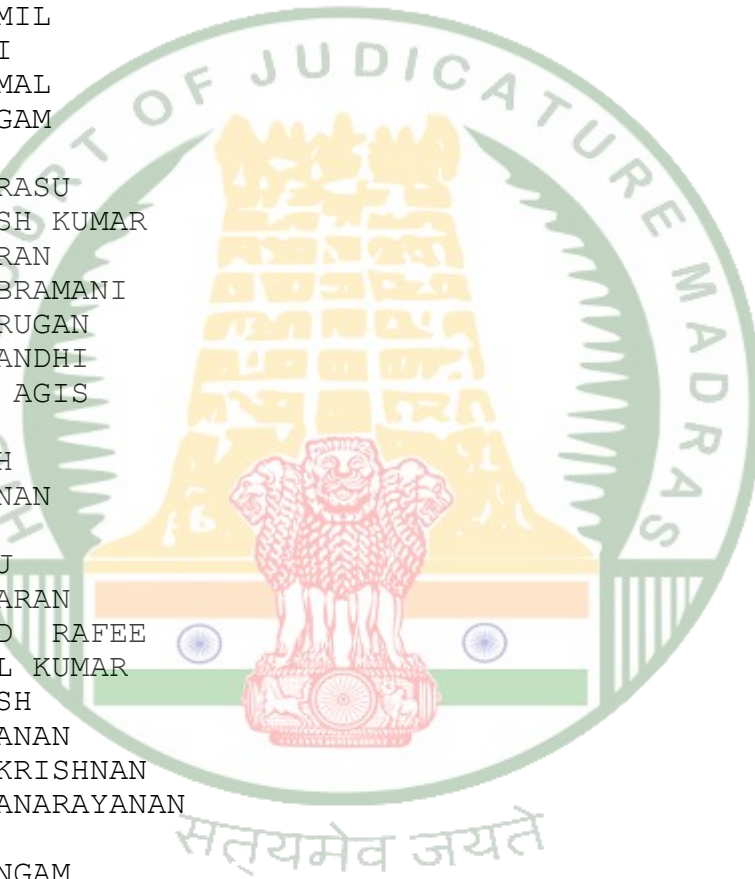

WP.9776 of 2016: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying to issue a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to grant continuity of service to the petitioners in category 2 (Armed Reserve) with all attendant benefits from the date of their appointment in category 3 / Tamilnadu Special Police in the year 2011 by incorporating the two increments of basic pay from the year 2014 and onwards on par with their original batch mates of the year 2011 recruited to category 3 / Tamil Nadu Special Police
