However, the petitioner is at liberty to file a fresh petition, on fresh cause of action, if so advised.

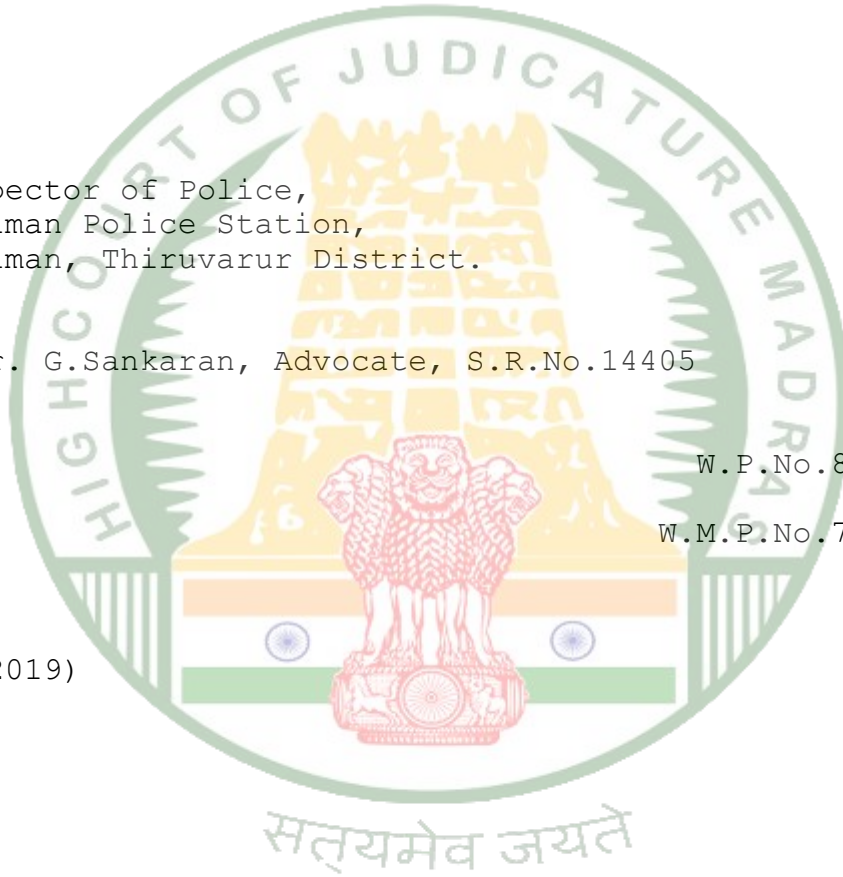
