Prayer:- This Writ Petition is filed, under the Article 226 of Constitution of India, to issue a writ of Mandamus, directing the 1st respondent herein to permit the petitioner to defend the domestic enquiry through the person of his choice as contemplated in Rule 23 clause 4 of the certified standing order of 1st respondent, and further direct the 2nd respondent herein to frame scheme and guideline in the matter of appointment of enquiry officer in the domestic enquiry against the industrial workers.

It is submitted by the learned counsel appearing for the 1st respondent that pending the Writ Petition, enquiry has been conducted and on conclusion of domestic enquiry, Writ Petitioner was found guilty of the charges levelled against him. Accordingly, he was dismissed from service on 04.06.2015. Challenging the said dismissal order, Petitioner has also raised

an Industrial Dispute before the First Additional Labour Court, Thane, in I.D.A.No.217/2016. Memo to the above effect has also been filed by the first respondent. The same is taken on file.

2. Recording the above, this Writ Petition is dismissed as nothing survives for adjudication. No costs. Consequently, connected MP is closed.

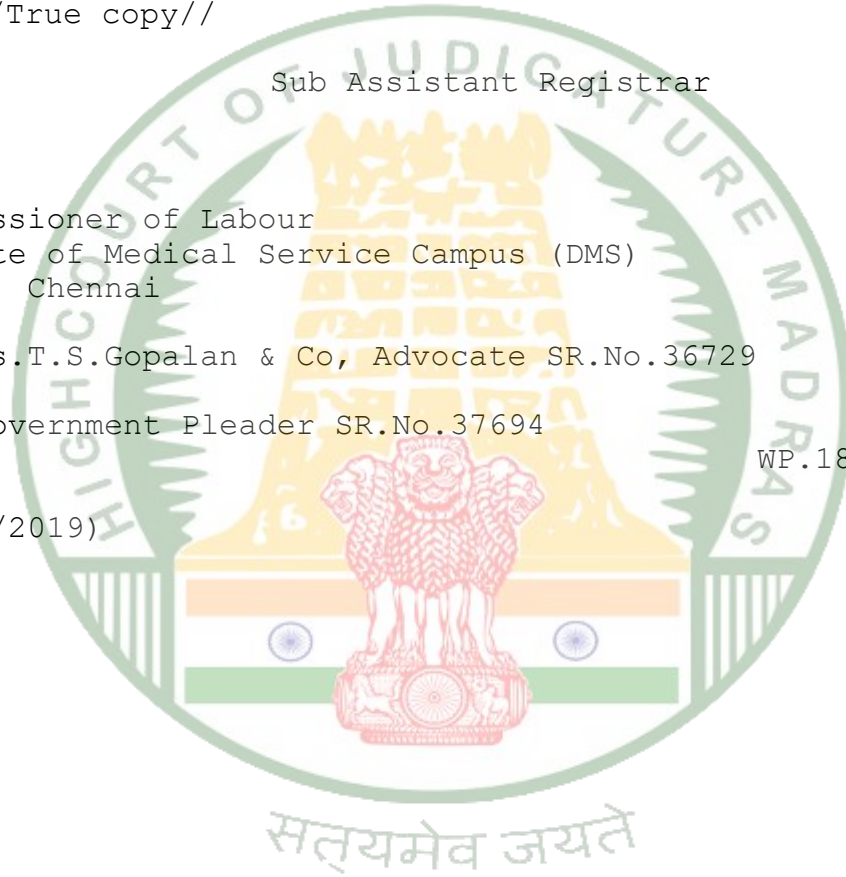
