PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, to issue a Writ of Certiorari Mandamus calling for the records from the file of the 1st respondent bearing G.O.Ms.No.310, Higher Education (D1) Department dated 13.11.2002 and G.O.Ms.No.253 Higher Education (D1) Department dated 31.07.2003 and quash the same insofar as it denies regularization from 01.07.1977 to the petitioner and also denies arrears of salary in the time scale of pay with effect from the said date to the petitioner and issue consequential direction to Respondents 1 and 2 to regularize the services of the Petitioner from 01.07.1977 and pay arrears of salary and allowances, together with interest at 12% per annum within a time frame.
