O R D E R

This petition has been filed seeking a direction, to direct the Learned Special Court Judge for SC/ST (POA) Act Cases, Villupuram to consider the bail application of the petitioner on his surrender before the Court on the same day on merits in accordance with law in connection with Crime No.179 of 2017 pending investigation on the file of the respondent.

2.In view of the amendments made in the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, this Court is of the view that the usual directions that were issued by this Court cannot be issued routinely in all cases. Therefore, the petitioners are directed to surrender before the trial Court within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and on such surrender, the learned Special Court Judge for SC/ST (POA) Act Cases, Villupuram shall deal with the matter on the same day on merits and in accordance with law, after issuing notice to the victims under Section 15 (A) of the SC/ST Act.

3. This Criminal Original Petition is disposed of with the above directions.

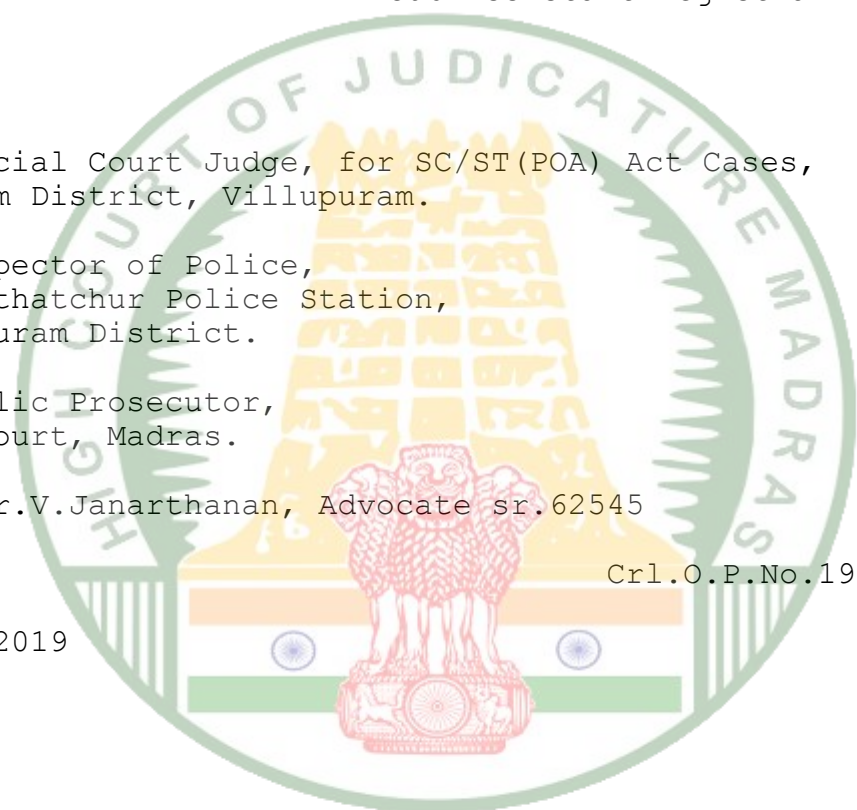
