ORDER

[Order of the court was made by Justice M.M.SUNDRESH]

The petitioner claims to be the lover of the detainee. Inter alia alleging that the detainee has been forcibly detained by the 3rd respondent, the present petition has been filed.

2. Today, the petitioner, the detainee and her parents are present. The detainee has informed us that she is not in the illegal detention. The petitioner has also agreed that he would

not have any relationship with the detenue in future. The parents of the detenue has also assured that they would ensure that the studies discontinued by the detenue would be revived.

3. In such view of the matter, this Habeas Corpus Petition stands dismissed, setting the detenue at liberty.

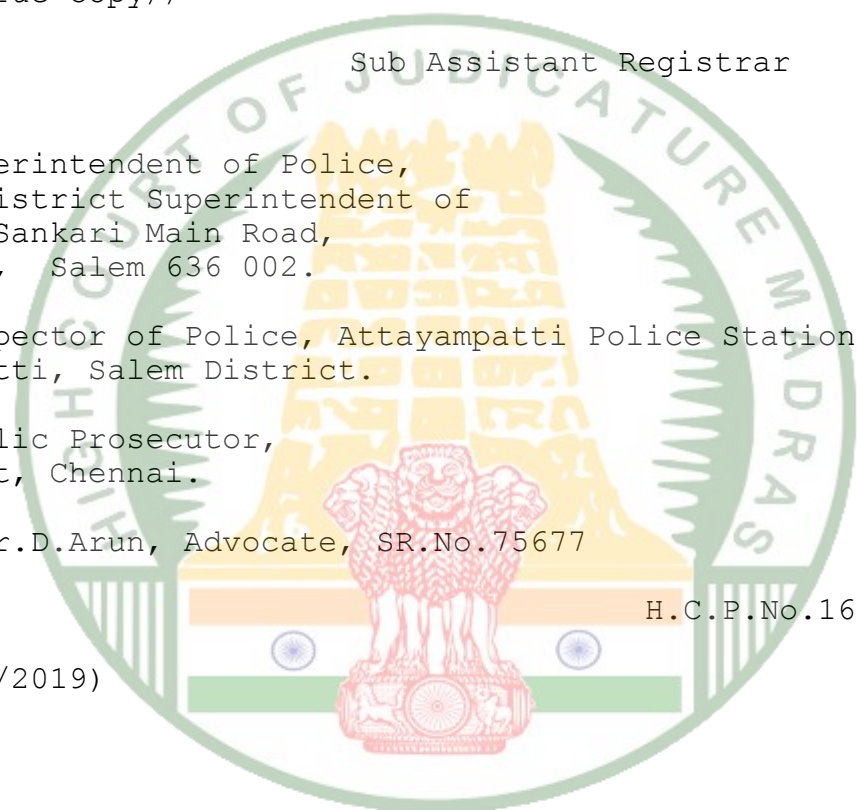
