4.There is no serious objection raised by the respondent side. Hence, these Civil Miscellaneous Petitions are allowed.

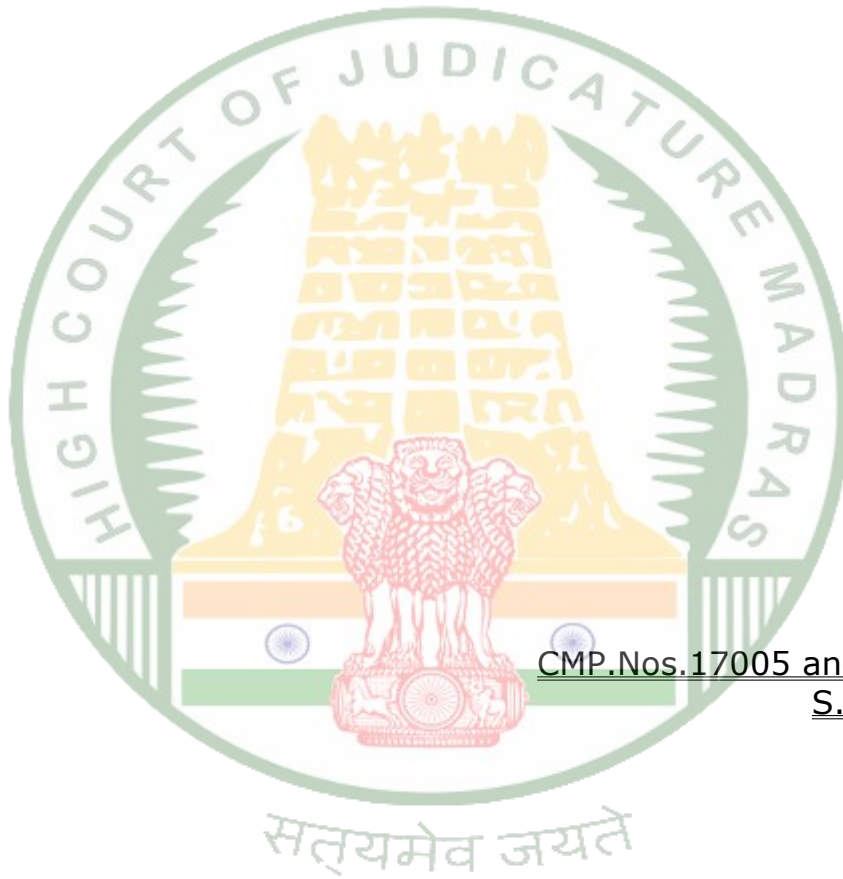
