Alleging that the detenu-Soundarya, who is the daughter of the petitioner, is under the illegal detention of the second respondent, the present habeas corpus petition has been filed.

also given a statement stating that no further action is required.

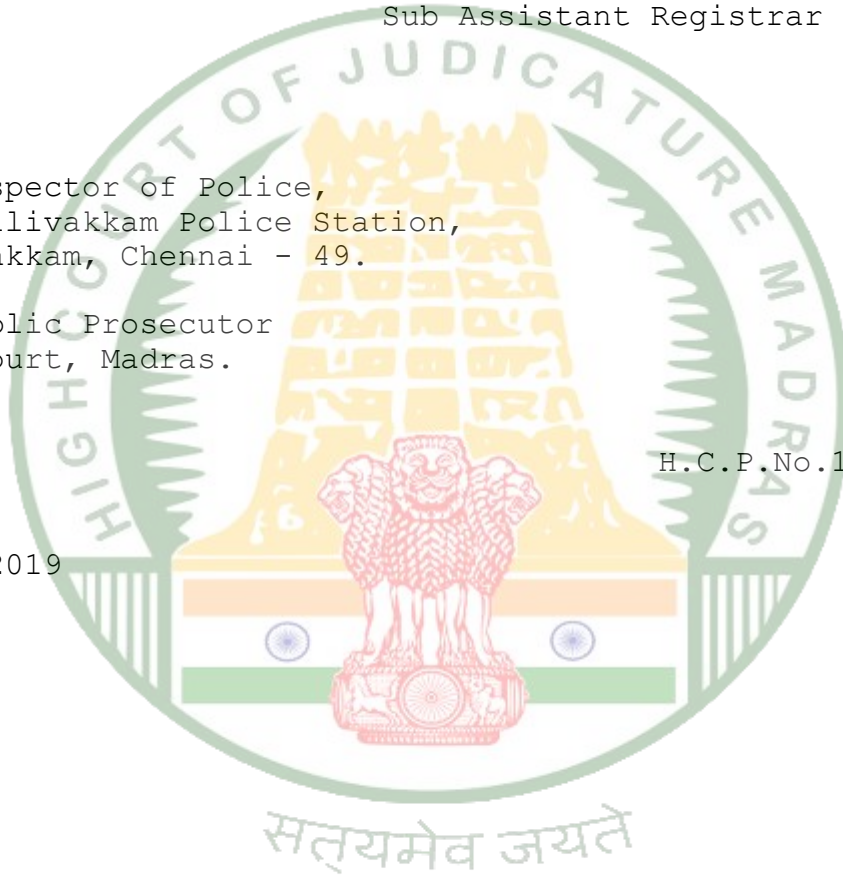
