ORDER

The only prayer made in the present writ petition is seeking expeditious disposal of the proceedings in A.P.No.11 of 2015, on the file the Debts Recovery Tribunal, Coimbatore.

2.Mr.R.Bharath Kumar, the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner urged before us that the proceedings are being dragged on in the said Tribunal and therefore, mandamus may be issued to the said Tribunal to expedite the said proceedings.

3.Having heard the learned counsels for the parties, we are satisfied that no such direction can be issued in the matter. The learned Tribunal is, ofcourse, expected to decide all the cases expeditiously, but singling out any particular case would only disrupt the entire process of the learned Tribunal, which is supposed to deal with all the matters, in accordance with law, according to its priority. Therefore, we are not inclined to issue the direction as prayed for in this writ petition. Accordingly, this writ petition stands dismissed. No costs.
