PRAYER: Criminal Original Petition is filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, to grant direction, directing the second respondent herein to file a Report pertaining to the detention of the detainee viz., Jayapradha D/o. Prabhakaran and in pursuance to direct the IV Metropolitan Magistrate Court, Saidapet, Chennai to dispose the CrI.M.P.No.(Not Known) of 2019 in crime No.32 of 2019 on the file of the first respondent police as expeditiously.

O R D E R

This petition has been filed by the mother of the detainee seeking for release of the detainee, who is now detained before the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent Government Home for Woman.

2.The first respondent registered an FIR in Crime No.32 of 2019 for the offences under Sections 3(2)(a), 4(1) and 5(1)(a) of Immoral Traffic Prevention Act, 1956. The petitioner is the mother of the fourth respondent, namely Jayapradha was produced before the IV Metropolitan Magistrate Court, Saidapet, Chennai showing her as a victim and she was detained in the home.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner filed a petition in Crl.M.P.No.Not Known of 2019 before the Court below seeking for the release of the petitioner's daughter and the same is kept pending on the ground that the P.O. report is yet to be filed before the Court. Aggrieved by the same, the present petition has been filed before this Court.

4.The learned counsel for the petitioner brought to the notice of this Court the earlier order passed by this Court in Crl.O.P.No.29421 of 2019, Crl OP No.2525 of 2019, Crl OP No.8202 of 2019 and Crl OP No.8733 of 2019, wherein this Court has dealt with an issue of similar nature.

5.Taking into consideration the earlier order passed by this Court and also the facts and circumstances of this case, this Court is inclined to direct the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent to immediately release the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent from the Government Home for Women, Mylapore. The petitioner before taking her daughter namely the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent from the home, shall produce necessary evidence to show her relationship with the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent. The 4<sup>th</sup> respondent on being released from the home, shall stay at Chennai and report before the IV Metropolitan Magistrate Court, Saidapet, Chennai, once in a week on Monday at 10.30 a.m., till the P.O. report is submitted before the Court.

6 This Criminal Original Petition is disposed of, with the above direction. Consequently, the connected miscellaneous petition is also closed.

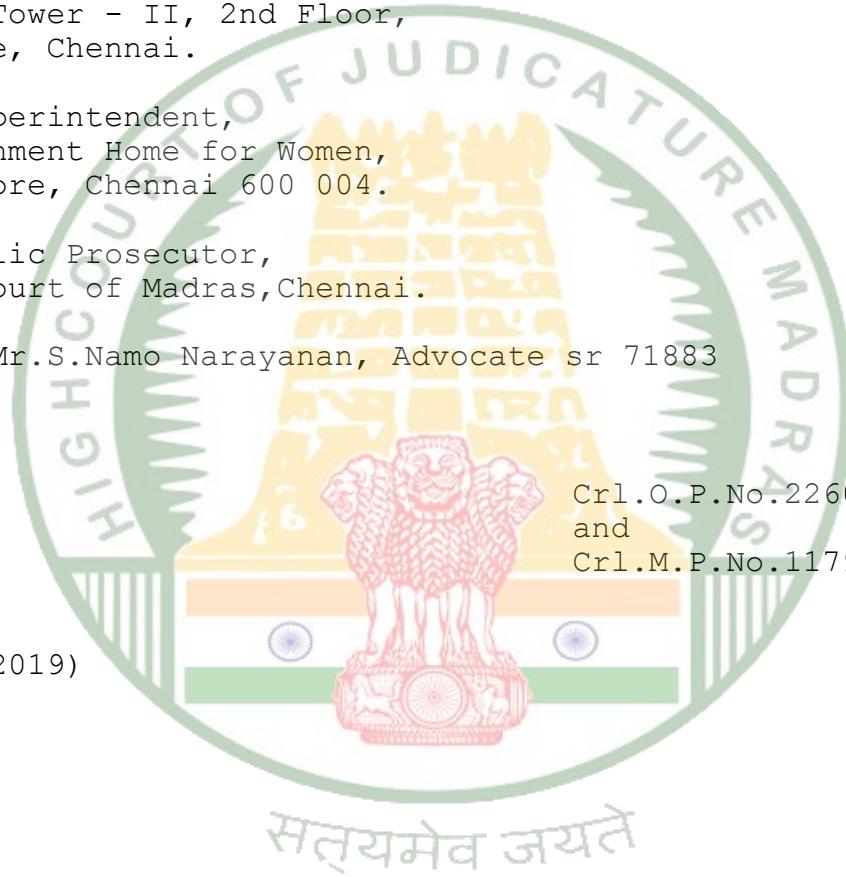
