The Writ Petition has been filed seeking grant of renewal of Lease of land measuring eight grounds in S.No.10119/1, V.O.C.Nagar, Pursaiwalkkam Taluk, Chennai for a period of thirty years as provided in Revenue Standing Order No.24A, to conduct the school of the petitioner.
