Seeking a direction to the second respondent to produce the petitioner's daughter namely Aishwarya, aged about 21 years, before this Court and set her at liberty, the present habeas corpus petition has been filed.

2. The detainee is produced before the Court. On enquiry, the detainee has stated that she is 20 years old and she has married one Surendhar.

3. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor has submitted that the petitioner was also present when the detainee was called for enquiry. During enquiry, the petitioner has stated that he will not have any association with the detainee.

4.In such view of the matter, we do not find any illegal detention involved. Accordingly, the habeas corpus petition stands closed.
