2. It is seen that the petitioner's complaint has been acted upon and the respondent herein had closed the complaint in C.S.R No.454 of 2019 on 15.08.2019. Hence, the appropriate remedy for the petitioner is to move the concerned Magistrate under Section 156(3) of the Cr.P.C. 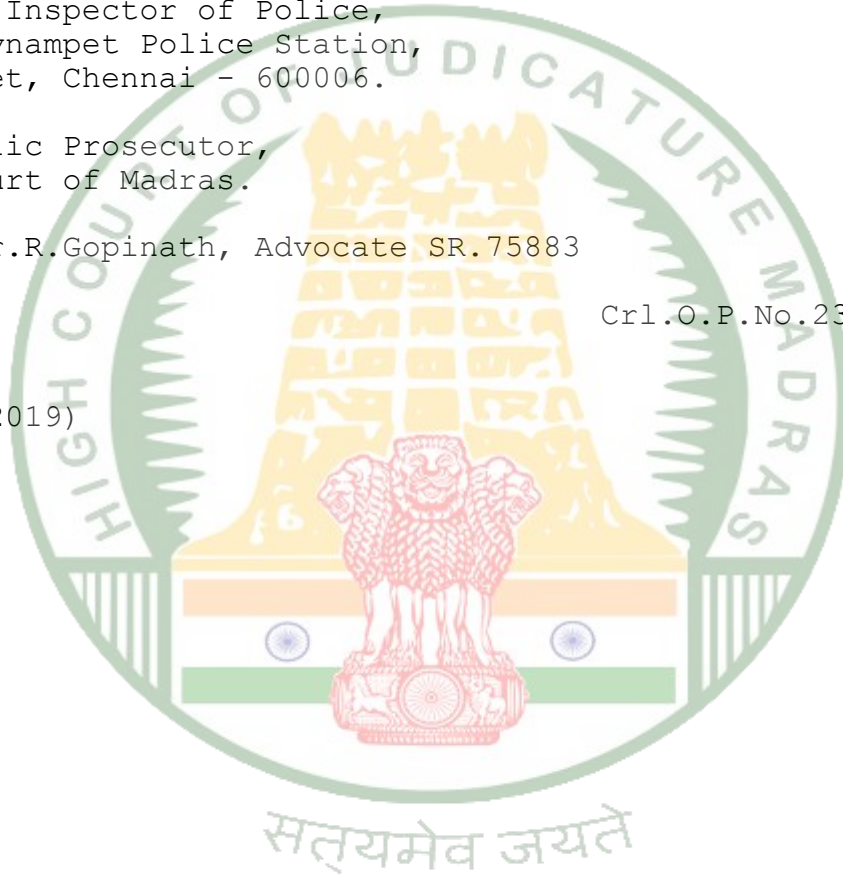
