ORDER

(Order of the Court was made by M.M.SUNDRESH, J.)

The petitioner is the wife of the detainee seeking production of her husband. Today, a status report has been filed by the first respondent. The status report indicates that the detainee is not in illegal custody of the second respondent. Investigation is still under way.

2. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner as well as the learned Additional Public Prosecutor.

3. On a perusal of the status report, we are satisfied that the investigation is moving in the right direction. Therefore, we are not inclined to keep this petition pending. However, the first respondent is directed to continue the investigation and make all endeavours to secure the detainee and produce him before jurisdiction as and when he is required.

4. In view of the above, the Habeas Corpus Petition stands closed.

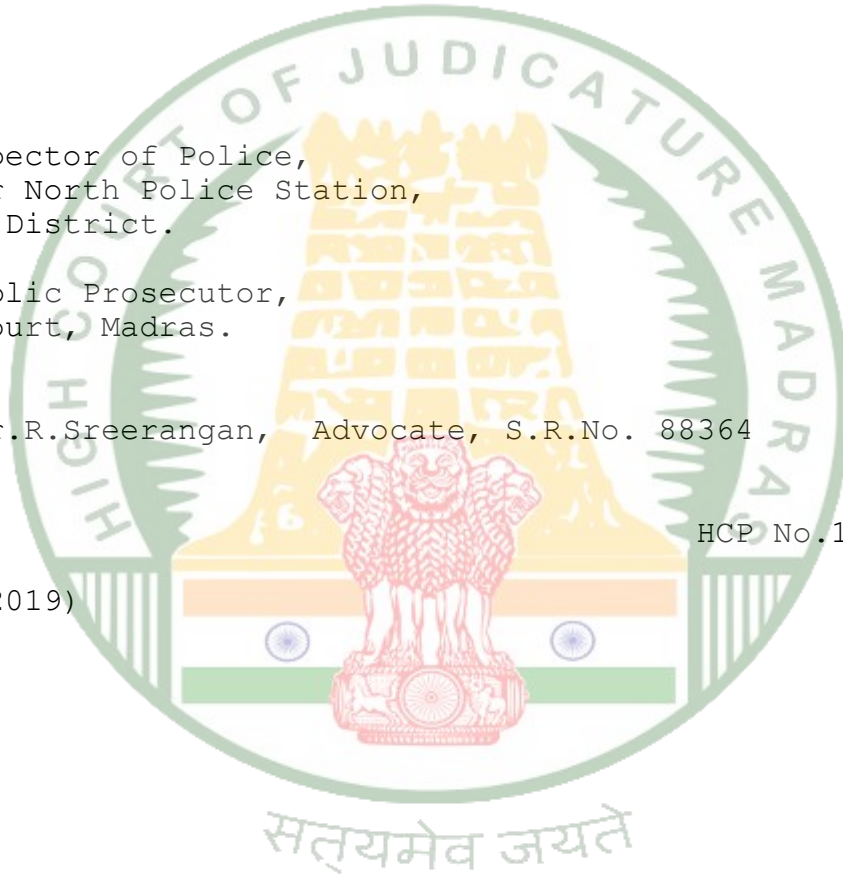
