Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying to issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, calling for the records relating to the impugned G.O.Ms.No.92 dated 29.02.2016, Health & Family Welfare Department and quash the same in so far as the same enabling the second and third respondents authorities to retain the original certificates of the petitioner and other PG students till they complete the bond

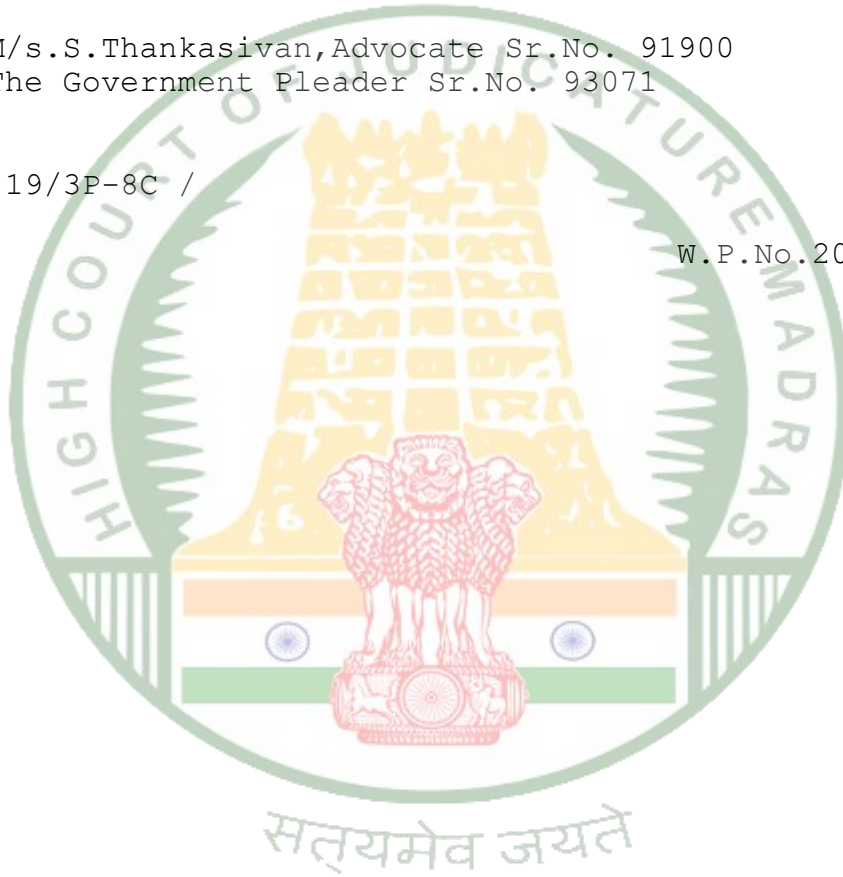
