Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, to issue a Writ of Habeas Corpus directing the detaining authority to produce the detenu petitioner's son namely M.Vinoth Kumar, aged about 23 years detained under Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 1982 after having been declared as a Goonda by preventive detention order dated 25.07.2019 passed by the second respondent in BCDFGISSSV No.435/2019 before this Court and presently confined at Central Prison, Puzhal, Chennai - 66 and quash the said preventive detention order dated 25.07.2019 bearing BCDFGISSSV No.435/2019 and set the detenu at liberty.

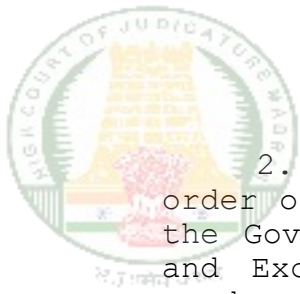

ORDER

The petitioner challenges the impugned order of detention in BCDFGISSSV No.435 of 2019, dated 25.07.2019, detaining her son as "Goonda", as contemplated under Section 2(f) of the Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 1982.

The learned Additional Public Prosecutor reports that the order of detention passed against the detenu has been revoked by the Government by its order in G.O.Rt.No.3598 Home, Prohibition and Excise (X) Department, dated 23.09.2019 and he has also produced a copy of the Government Order. Recording the same, this Habeas Corpus Petition stands closed.
