Prayer: Criminal Original Petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. to direct the 3rd respondent to file a report pertaining to the detention of the detainee by name Sindu and in pursuance direct the Judicial Magistrate Court, Sulur to dispose CrI.M.P.No.2689 of 2019 in Crime No.705 of 2019 as expeditiously.

O R D E R

This petition has been filed by the mother of the detainee seeking for release of the detainee, who is now detained before

the 3rd respondent Government Protective Home.

2. The 1st respondent registered an FIR in Crime No.705 of 2019 for the offences under Sections 3(2)(a), 3(2)(b), 4(2)(c), and 5(1)(a), of Immoral Traffic Prevention Act, 1956. The petitioner is the mother of the 4th respondent, namely Sindu, who was produced before the learned Judicial Magistrate Court, Sulur showing her as a victim and she was detained in the home.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner filed a petition in CrI.M.P.No.2689 of 2019 before the Court below, seeking for the release of the petitioner's daughter and the same is kept pending on the ground that the P.O. report is yet to be filed before the Court. Aggrieved by the same, the present petition has been filed before this Court.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner brought to the notice of this Court the earlier orders passed by this Court in CrI.O.P.No.27063 of 2018, CrI.O.P.No.26714 of 2018, CrI.O.P.No.29421 of 2018 and CrI.O.P.No.18627 of 2019, wherein this Court has dealt with an issue of similar nature.

5. Taking into consideration the earlier orders passed by this Court and also the facts and circumstances of this case, this Court is inclined to direct the 3rd respondent to immediately release the 4th respondent from the Government Protective Home, 315A, Kanthasamy garden Street, Sanganoor, Coimbatore. The petitioner, before taking her daughter namely the 4th respondent from the home, shall produce necessary evidence to show her relationship with the 4th respondent. The 4th respondent, on being released from the home, shall stay at Chennai and report before the learned Judicial Magistrate Court, Sulur, once in a week on Monday at 10.30 a.m., till the P.O. report is submitted before the Court.

6. This Criminal Original Petition is disposed of, with the above directions.

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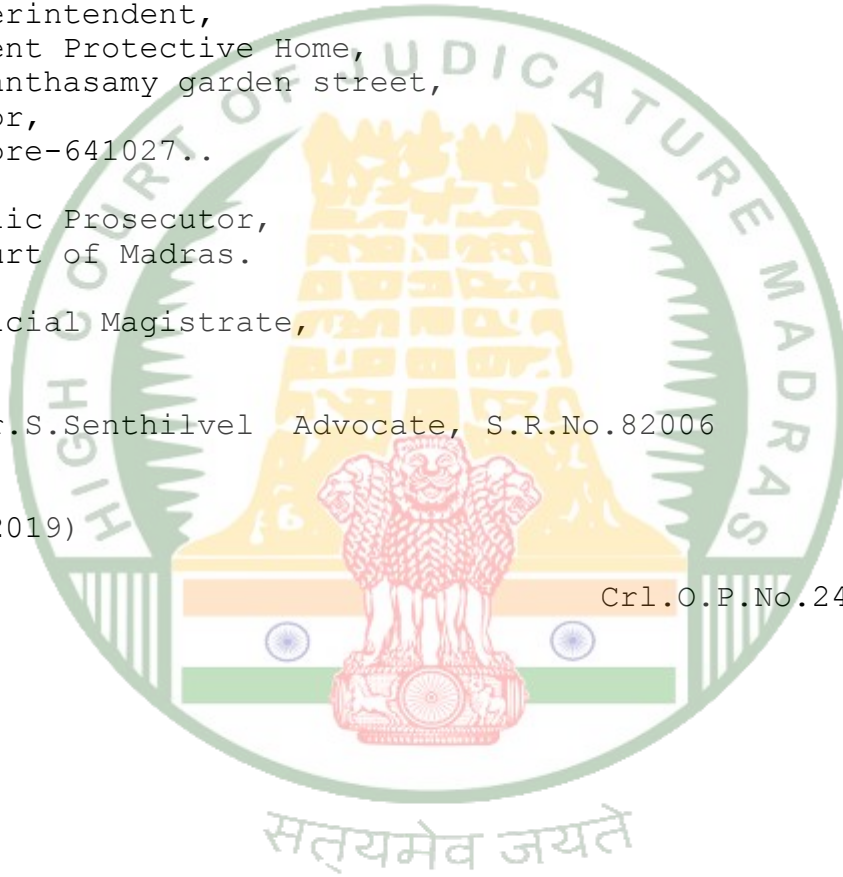
