3.After hearing both sides, as a preliminary hearing, this Court feels that, the issue raised in this revision can be decided after having a detailed hearing of both sides in the main revision.

4.Insofar as the stay petition in C.M.P.No.20912 of 2019 is concerned, this Court feels that there is no *prima facie* case to interfere with the impugned order passed by the Tribunal, mainly on the ground of want of jurisdiction, as has been primarily projected by the revision petitioner.

5.In that view of the matter, the C.M.P.No.20912 of 2019 is dismissed. Post the main CRP on 7th November 2019 for final hearing.
