The criminal miscellaneous petition is filed seeking to relax the conditional order imposed by this Court on the petitioner/appellant vide order dated 10.06.2019 made in Crl.MP.No.7048/2019 in Crl.A.No.318/2019.

2 This Court, in its order dated 10.06.2019, had suspended the sentence imposed on the petitioner with a direction to report before the Trial Court on the first working day of every month until further orders.

3 The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that 1st petitioner is working at Perunkalathur and 2nd petitioner is the mother of the 1st petitioner aged about 65 years and she is a widow and due to the ill health of the 2nd petitioner and thereby, would seek that the condition of appearing before the Trial Court on the first working day of every month, be modified.

submit that the petitioner is complying with the condition regularly.

5 This Court also perused the affidavit filed in support of the miscellaneous petition.

6 Taking into consideration, the averments made in the affidavit, the condition imposed vide order dated 10.06.2019, is hereby **modified** and the petitioners shall appear before the Trial Court **once in three months on the first working day at 10.30 a.m, pending Appeal.**

7 The petition is ordered accordingly.
