O R D E R

The limited prayer sought for in the present writ petition is for a direction to the respondents to consider the

petitioner's representation dated 24.04.2019 seeking compensation under the Tamil Nadu Victim Compensation Scheme, 2013.

2. Whenever a representation of its nature is made, the statutory authority is to bound to consider such a representation in accordance with law instead of keeping the petition pending indefinitely. The non-consideration of such representation would amount to dereliction of duty on the part of the statutory authorities and therefore, the petitioner would be justified in invoking Article 226 of Constitution of India.

3. In the light of the above observation, there shall be a direction to the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent to consider the petitioner's representation, on its own merits and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible, in any event, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

4. The Writ Petition is disposed of accordingly. No Costs.

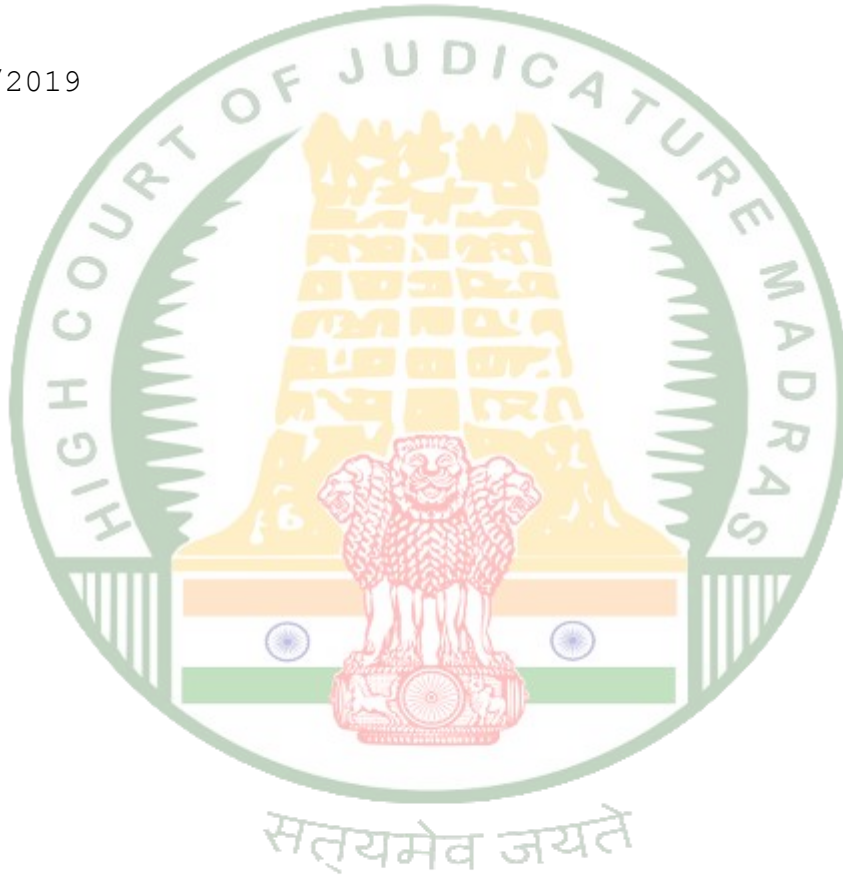
