2. I do not find any infirmity in the finding of the First Appellate Court while lodging an application under Section 391 of Cr.P.C. since ample opportunity to cross examine the witnesses has been provided and present attempt is only to fill up the lacunae.

3. The grounds raised by the learned counsel for the petitioner also reflects that the question which the petitioner intends to raise is to overcome the lacunae created before the trial court. Hence, no interference is required for the present case, the Criminal Original Petition stands dismissed.
