enquiry conducted by the RDOs with the Anthropologist in respect of Villupuram, Tindivanam and Chengalpet District and issue the community certificates to the petitioners and their children in the respective writ petitions namely S.Buvanesh based on the petitioner's application dated 16.04.2019 (W.P.No.30504 of 2019), L.Deepalakshmi and L.Porchelvan based on the petitioner's application dated 16.04.2019 (W.P.No.30505 of 2019), A.Suresh, A.Kathiravan and A.Sanjai based on the petitioner's application dated 16.04.2019 (W.P.No.30508 of 2019), T.Sasidharan and T.Mavin based on the petitioner's application dated 16.04.2019 (W.P.No.30510 of 2019) and M. Krishnamoorthy, M.Selvi and M.Gowri based on the petitioner's application dated 17.04.2019 (W.P.No.30511 of 2019).

COMMON ORDER

[Order of the Court was made by M.M.SUNDRESH, J.]

In view of the commonality of the issue involved in all these writ petitions, they have been taken up together and disposed of by a common order.

2.In all these cases, the petitioners made applications seeking issuance of certificate as one belonging to Hindu Katunayakkan Community, which is a Scheduled Tribe Community. Now, inasmuch as the applications made are stated to be still pending with the respondent, seeking appropriate orders, these writ petitions have been filed.

3.We have heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondents.

4.Learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondents would submit that in accordance with law, these applications will be considered and appropriate orders will be passed.

5.In such view of the matter, a direction is issued to the respective respondents to pass appropriate orders on the applications made by the petitioners by conducting enquiry, if so required, in the manner known to law. The aforesaid process will have to be completed within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6.With the aforesaid direction, all these writ petitions stand disposed of. No costs.

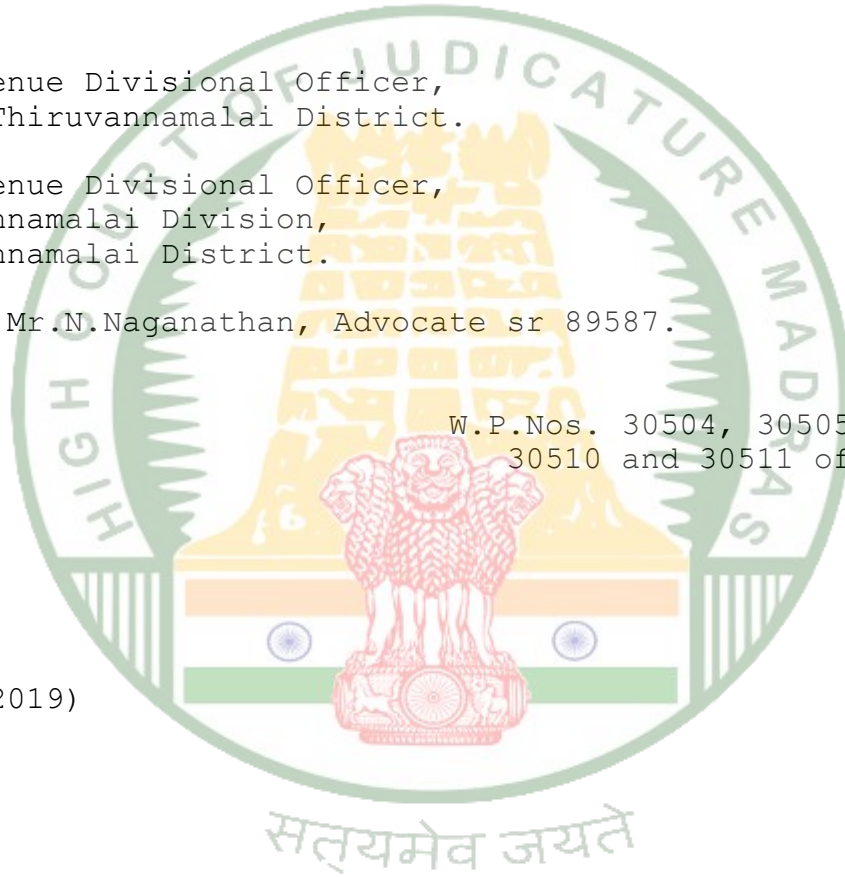
