As such, the purpose for which the Look-out Circular has been issued in Crime No.09 of 2018 has been served and therefore, in view of various decisions of this Court, the Look-out Circular lapses.

3. In view of the same, the Look-out Circular dated 04.05.2019 issued against the petitioner herein shall stand quashed. If at the respondents police are of the view that the petitioner's presence, who claims to have been released on bail, is once again required, it is always open to them to seek for a fresh Look-out Circular.

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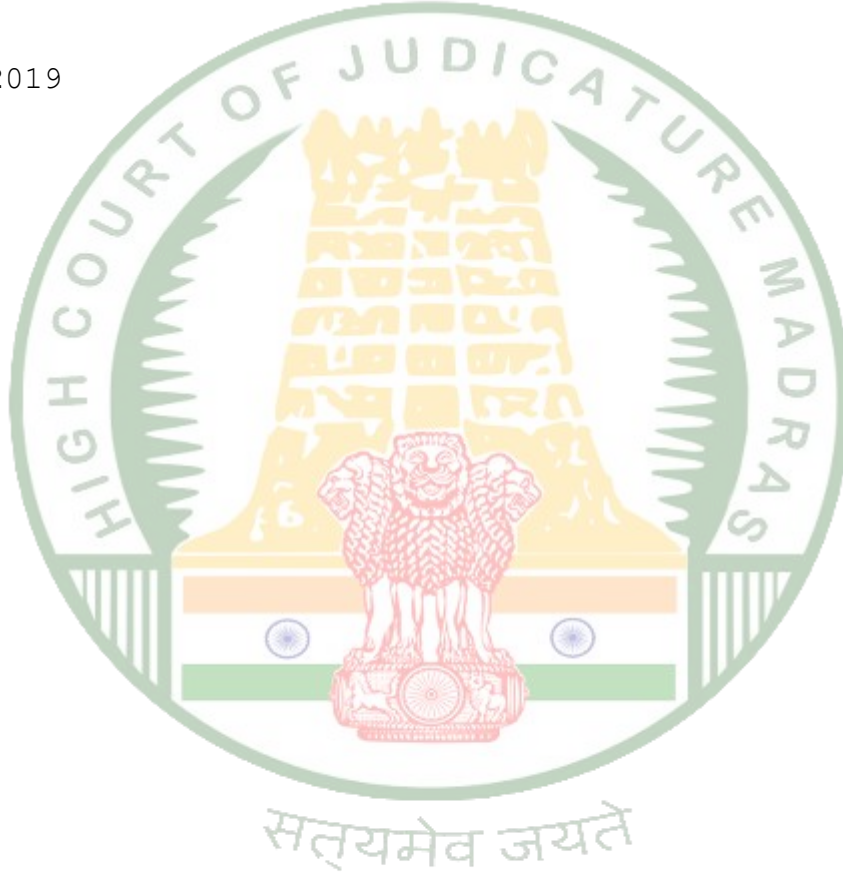
