ORDER

When the matter is taken up, learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondents producing a copy of the Letter dated 19.11.2019 of the first respondent stated that the prayer made in the writ petition has become infructuous, since the sale deed in question sought to be released was already handed over to Mr.K.Kumaresan and Ms.Varalakshmi on 11.08.2018 itself.

3. Recording the above said submission as well as the Letter dated 19.11.2019 of the first respondent addressed to the learned Government Advocate, the writ petition is dismissed as infructuous. No Costs. W.M.P.No.3279 of 2017 is closed.

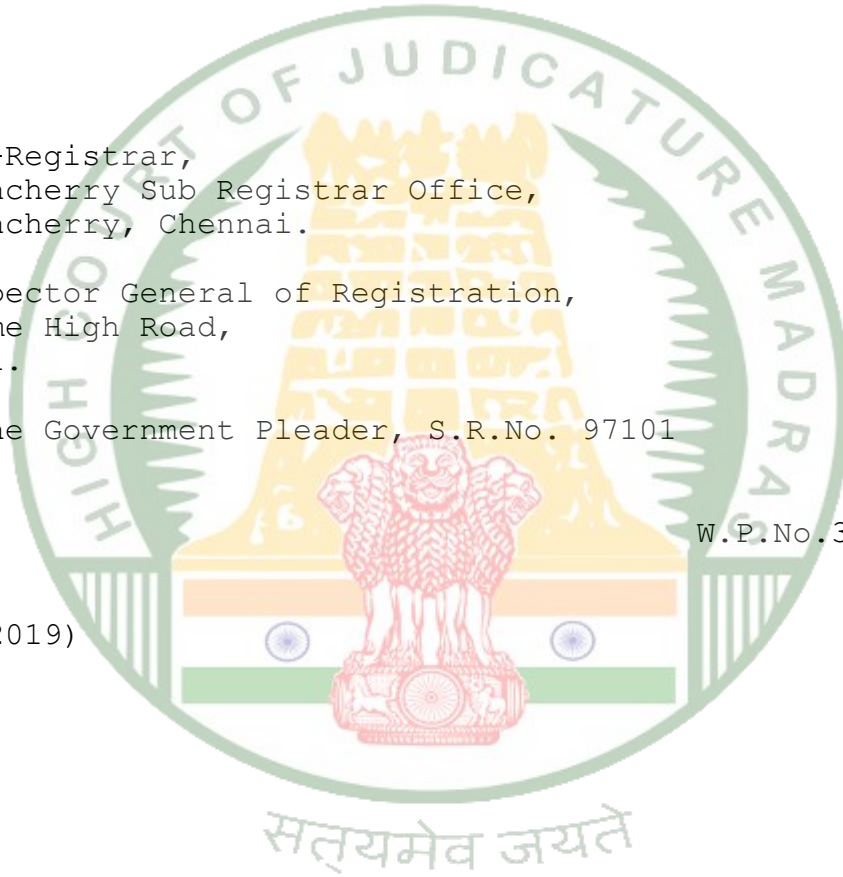
