3 Heard both sides.

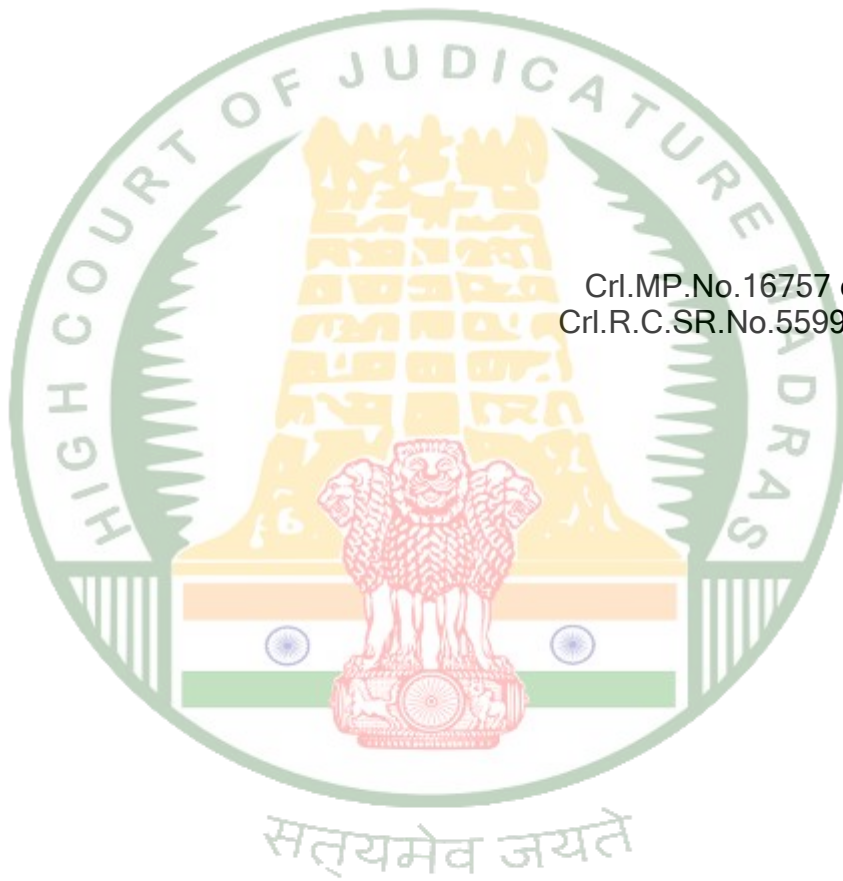
