The prayer in the present petition cannot be maintained, since the cause of action is yet to arise for the relief sought for. Apprehending that the petitioner might be detained or shifted from the Special Camp cannot be made as a cause of action seeking for a Writ of Mandamus, and hence the very prayer itself could be considered as prematured. Hence, the Writ Petition stands dismissed. No costs. Consequently, the connected Miscellaneous Petition is also closed.

2. At this juncture, the learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that they intend to make an appropriate application seeking for citizenship.

3. It is needless to point out that if at all such a right is available to the petitioner, it is always open to him to work out his remedies in accordance with law.
