This miscellaneous petition has been filed seeking to suspend the sentence imposed on the petitioner by judgment dated 23.12.2016 in S.C.No.5 of 2014 by the learned Sessions Judge (Mahalir Neethimandram, Chennai), Court of Sessions, Chennai, and enlarge the petitioner on bail pending disposal of the above criminal appeal.

2. Heard both sides.

3. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, this miscellaneous petition is allowed and the substantive sentence of imprisonment alone is suspended and the petitioner is released on bail on condition that the petitioner shall deposit a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) to the credit of S.C.No.5 of 2014 on the file of the Sessions Judge (Mahalir Neethimandram, Chennai), Court of Sessions, Chennai, and further the petitioner shall execute a bond for

for a like sum to the satisfaction of the Magalir Neethimandram, Chennai. Further, the petitioner shall appear before the trial Court on the first working day of every month at 10.30 a.m until further orders.
