If the petitioner lodged a complaint, he has to co-operate for enquiry. If he is called for enquiry with regard to his complaint, it cannot be said that he is being harassed.

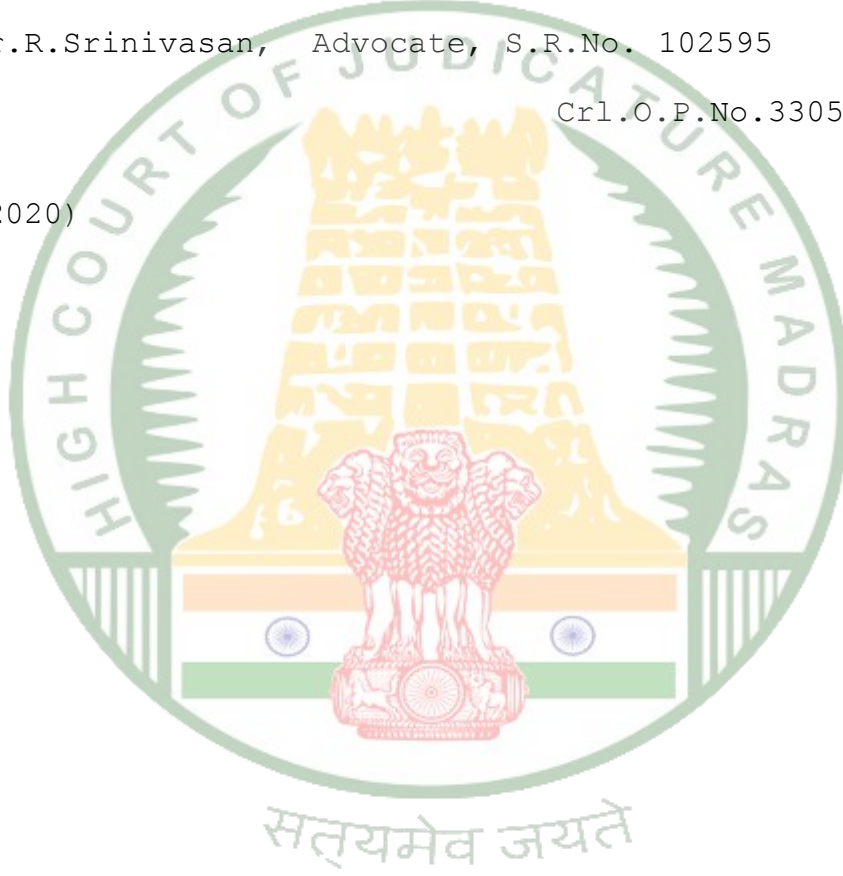
