The Petitioner has filed this petition seeking to relax the condition imposed on the petitioner to appear before the XI Additional Sessions Judge, Chennai, once in three months.

2.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that due to ill health, the petitioner could not appear before the Trial Court on 02.12.2019. When the same was represented before the Trial Court, the learned XI Additional Sessions Judge directed to move this condonation before this Court. Hence, the petitioner is before this Court and prays for appropriate orders.

3.Considering the ill health of the petitioner, the absence of the petitioner on 02.12.2019 is hereby condoned.

4.The condition imposed on the petitioner in Crl.M.P.No.7307 of 2016 dated 13.07.2016 in Crl.A.No.504 of 2016 is hereby modified to the effect that the petitioner shall appear before the Trial Court once in a year i.e. 1st week of January 2020. The other conditions of the order shall stand unaltered.
