This miscellaneous petition has been filed seeking to suspend the sentence imposed on the petitioner by judgment dated 02.01.2017 in Spl.S.C.No.60 of 2015 on the file of the learned Sessions Judge, Fast Track Mahila Court, Dharmapuri District, and enlarge the petitioner on bail pending disposal of the above appeal.

2. Heard both sides.

3. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, the miscellaneous petition is ordered and the substantive sentence of imprisonment alone is suspended and the petitioner is released on bail on condition that the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Palacode. Further, the petitioner shall appear before the trial Court on the first working day of every month at 10.30 a.m until further orders.

Post the main revision on 08.02.2019.
