PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, to issue a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondents to extend the benefits of G.O.Ms.No.89, Environment and Forest (FR-2) Department dated 18.07.2017 so as to enable the petitioners to get the benefit of retrospective regularisation of their service in the cadre of Forest Watcher Grade-II on completion of 10 years of service on daily wage basis by considering their representations dated 18.02.2018, 02.03.2018 and 14.02.2018 respectively and in the light of the order dated 24.10.2016 passed in W.P.No.17568 of 2010, within a period to be specified by this Court.
